Sola Scriptura – Part 2 By Arthur Lovato

STOP listening to your neo-Christian YouTube celebrity preachers and supposing that will suffice as time spent in God's Word!

What are the deceptions of this day and age?

They will tell you there will be no rapture. They will tell you that the church is to usher in the millennial reign of Christ by taking control of the seven spheres of society. They will call themselves prophets and apostles falsely and promote their unbiblical doctrines and sell them to us as new or extra biblical revelation. This is what Joseph Smith did when he started Mormonism, and what Charles Taze Russell did in starting the Jehovah's Witness cult. Beware of the new apostolic reformation. Their unbiblical doctrines are very clever, and subtly masked. So subtle is the enemy that even well churched believers are missing it and believing the lies. If you hear terms like; seven mountains mandate, dominionism, Kingdom now, or subdue the earth, Joel's army, or latter rain, Run! They will preach complete sermons and never open God's Word or quote the Scripture incompletely or out of context. PAY ATTENTION! RUN!

There are others who will tell you aliens or UFOs have biblical relevance or significance. This is an example of both metaphysical new age teachings mixed with doctrines of the Word of God. There are those who will claim exclusive, divine and mystical revelation of codes hidden in the Scriptures. The theory that there are hidden messages in the Torah is rooted in Kabbalah, or traditional Jewish mysticism. The claims of exclusive biblical revelation are also a form of Gnosticism.

Listen here, in Galatians 1:6-9 (KJV), "I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, if any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed."

"I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the One who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel—which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the Gospel of Christ. But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let them be under God's curse! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let them be under God's curse!" (Galatians 1:6-9 NIV)

Why then do men chase this nonsense down? Here's what the Bible says;

In 1 Corinthians 1:22 (KJV), "For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom." (A stumbling block to the Jews and foolishness to the Greeks.)

Mark 8:11 (KJV), "And the Pharisees came forth, and began to question with him, seeking of him a sign from heaven, tempting him."

Deuteronomy 6:16 (KJV), "Ye shall not tempt the LORD your God, as ye tempted him in Massah." God don't play that! God don't do parlor tricks for your amusement.

Matthew 12:39 (KJV), "But He answered and said unto them, 'An evil and adultarous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jones."

Matthew 12:39-40 (NIV), "He answered, 'A wicked and adulterous generation asks for a signi But none will be given it except the sign of the prophet Joneh. For as Joneh was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth." There's your sign.

Why would I say such things to you? I'm gonna give you two verses to answer that.

Matthew 24:24 (KJV), "For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect."

"For false messiahs and false prophets will rise up and perform great signs and wonders so as to deceive, if possible, even God's chosen ones." (Matthew 24:24 NLT)

And Deuteronomy 18:20-22 (KJV), "But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die. And if thou say in thine heart, How shall we know the word which the LORD hath not spoken? When a prophet speaketh in the name of the LORD, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him."

"But a prophet who presumes to speak in My name anything I have not commanded, or a prophet who speaks in the name of other gods, is to be put to death. You may say to yourselves, 'How can we know when a message has not been spoken by the Lord?' If what a prophet proclaims in the name of the Lord does not take place or come true, that is a message the Lord has not spoken. That prophet has spoken presumptuously, so do not be alarmed." (Deuteronomy 18:20-22 NIV)

What does this mean, "A prophet who falsely claims to speak for the Lord, or a prophet who speaks on behalf of another god, must be put to death."? The Lord will validate His prophets by ensuring that what they predict will come to pass. The Scripture is clear; miss one prophecy and you're a fake. When you are in error in doctrine you open yourself up to the doctrine of demons and demonic influence.

Let's continue in Joshua 1:8 (KJV), "This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success."

"Don't get off track, either left or right, so as to make sure you get to where you're going. And don't for a minute let this Book of The Revelation be out of mind. Ponder and meditate on it day and night, making sure you practice everything written in it." (Joshua 1:7-8 MSG) Wade added verse 7 here to put even more emphasis on not getting distracted.

Luke 11:28 (KJV), "But He said, 'Yea rather, blassed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it.""

"Jesus replied, 'But even more blassed are all who hear the Word of God and put it into practice." (Luke 11:28 NLT)

So, what did Jesus say we should be doing? He said in Matthew 24:14 (KJV), "And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come."

"And this Gospel of the kingdom will be presched in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come." (Matthew 24:14 NIV) The very Gospel John the Baptist preached; Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand!

We are called to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ without falter or error in simplicity and truth equipping and preparing the church for the coming of our King according to the Scriptures.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 (KJV), "For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."

"For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever." (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 NIV)

And as we eagerly await the coming of our King, we will lead the lost to the Cross!

This command, or often noted as 'The Great Commission' is found here in *Matthew 28:19-20* (KJV), "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, Io, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen."

I'll close with these last few Scriptures.

2 Timothy 2:15 (KJV), "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

"Work hard so you can present yourself to God and receive His approval. Be a good worker, one who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly explains the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15 NLT)

1 Peter 3:15 (KJV), "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear."

"But even if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it. So don't worry or be afraid of their threats. Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a

I'm NOT Just a Statistic By J.D.

I was reading through Deuteronomy yesterday and as I was praying and meditating on the Word of God when a revelation came across my heart. In *Deuteronomy 30*, right before Moses is to go and "be joined to his people", he is renewing the Lord's covenant with the Israelites. Moses prophetically speaks in this chapter, saying that when you find yourself back in captivity, God is faithful and just and quick to forgive. I see here that the Lord allowed Moses to see Israel's future, and to see their disobedience that would come after his death. Moses' message here was not "don't do this" and "don't do that". The Lord allowed Moses to see into the hearts of the Israelites, into the hearts of men. Moses was able to see that there was no avoiding what was to come. So, instead of the "don't do this" and "don't do that", Moses preached a message of repentance. His message was a message of grace and love. Moses simply said in *Deuteronomy 30:3*, "The Lord your God will bring you back from captivity and have compassion on you."

I relate this to my old lifestyle and the person that I used to be. The liar had me completely convinced that I was a slave to my circumstances. The enemy had me convinced that I was powerless and would forever live outside the law. I believed that my life was forever going to be one big "statistic" so to speak. The revelation here is that we ALL have a choice. The choice is obedience that leads to life or disobedience leading to death. When you find yourself in captivity or being held prisoner to sin, if you repent and return to the Lord, He will restore you and strengthen you. WE WILLINGLY BECOME SLAVES TO SIN AND WE WILLINGLY CAN BREAK FREE FROM IT AS WELL. God gave us ALL the choice to decide, and He even forewarned us of where each decision would lead us in *Deuteronomy 30:15-18*, "Now listen! Today I am giving you a choice between life and death, between prosperity and disaster. For I command you this day to love

If you do this, you will live and multiply, and the Lord your God will bless you and the land you are about to enter and occupy. God Never Gives Us More Than We Can Handle By J.T.

I know this pressure is coming from God's call for me to be a leader amongst men while I still deal with my own afflictions. As I reflect on this I'm reminded of the Apostle Paul. Foot's Bible Study

Micah 1:1-4:13

The people of Lachish had influenced many to follow their evil example. They led Jerusalem into sin. We often do the same when we sin. Regardless of whether you consider yourself a leader, your daily actions and words are observed by others who may choose to follow your example, whether you know it or not. (1:13)

When God reveals the future, His purpose goes beyond satisfying our curiosity. He wants us to change our present behavior because of what we know about the future. Forever begins now, and a glimpse of God's plan for His followers should motivate us to serve Him, no matter what the rest of the world may do. (4:12)

Revelation 5:1-6:17

People from every nation are praising God before His throne. God's message of Salvation and eternal life is not limited to a specific culture, race, or country. Anyone who comes to God in repentance and faith is accepted by Him and will be part of His kingdom. Don't allow prejudice or bias to keep you from sharing Christ with others. Christ welcomes all people into His kingdom. (5:9-10)

At the sight of God sitting on the throne, all human beings great and small, will be terrified, with many calling for the mountains to fall on them so that they will not have to face the judgment of the Lamb. This vivid picture was not intended to frighten believers. For them, the Lamb is a great Savior. But those kings, rulers, generals, and other powerful people who previously showed no fear of God and arrogantly flaunted their unbelief will find that they were wrong, and in that day, they will have to face God's wrath. No one who has rejected God can survive the day of His wrath, but those who belong to Christ will receive a reward rather than a punishment. Do you belong to Christ? If so, you need not fear the final days. (6:15-17)

Psalms 134:1-3

This psalm is about a very small group, the Levites who served as Temple watchmen. Singing this psalm, the last of the "Songs of Ascent", Psalm 134:1-3, "Oh, praise the Lord, all you servants of the Lord, you who serve at night in the house of the Lord. Lift your hands toward the sanctuary, and praise the Lord. May the Lord, who made heaven and earth, bless you from Jerusalem." The worshippers would ascend on the hill where the Temple sat and see the watchmen who protected it, day and night. They saw the watchmen work as an act of praise to God, done reverently and responsibly. Make your job or your responsibility in the church an act of praise by doing it with reverence to God. Honor Him by the quality of your work and the attitude of service you bring to it. (134:1-3)

Proverbs 30:1-4

Because God is infinite, certain aspects of His nature will always remain a mystery. Compare these questions with the questions God asked Job. Read Job 38-41. (30:2-4)

believer, always be ready to explain it." (1 Peter 3:14-15 NLT) Again, Wade added verse 14. Know God and His Word so intimately, that you are always prepared to give a sound scriptural answer to why we believe as we do and do so with humility and a reverence for a Holy God.

Allow me to reiterate; If you open yourself up to doctrines that do not line up with the Word of God, you open yourself up to the demonic influence of deception. We often repeat secular cliches such as 'eat the meat and spit out the bones', but this very statement contradicts the Scripture.

Galatians 5:9 (KJV), "A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump."

"This false teaching is like a little yeast that spreads through the whole batch of dough!" (Galatians 5:9 NLT)

If we do not know the Word, the Bread of Life, and know Him intimately, it is not unbiblical to say the deceptions of this age and could lead you to run the wrong race.

Matthew 7:13-14 (KJV), "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in therest: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it."

"You can enter God's Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to half is broad, and its gate is wide for the many who choose that way. But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it." (Matthew 7:13-14 NLT)

Did You Know?

Dads across the United States will be honored as they celebrate Father's Day. Though it's something we can count on celebrating every time the third Sunday in June rolls around, the holiday didn't always have the public support it deserved. In fact, for decades it looked as if a day dedicated to the influential and hard-working fathers in our lives would toil in relative obscurity. Read on to learn about this beloved holiday.

The first modern Father's Day was rooted in tragedy.

On July 5, 1908, the same year that Mother's Day is credited as beginning—a small church in West Virginia held the first public event meant to specifically honor the fathers of their community. The day was held in remembrance of the 362 men who were killed the previous December in a mining explosion at the Fairmont Coal Company. Though this specific day did not transform into an annual tradition in the town, it did set a precedent of reserving a day for dads everywhere.

Washington was the first state to celebrate Father's Day.

In 1909, Spokane resident Sonora Smart Dodd was listening to a Mother's Day sermon at her local church when she had the idea to try to establish a similar day to honor the hard-working fathers of the community. Dodd was the daughter of a widower and Civil War veteran named William Jackson Smart, who raised six children on his own after his wife died during childbirth. She contacted local church groups, government officials, YMCAs, businesses, and other official entities, hoping to gather the community to recognize fathers around the state of Washington. The campaign Dodd embarked upon would eventually culminate in the first statewide Father's Day celebration in 1910.

That Father's Day takes place on the third Sunday in June just happened by accident.

While Father's Day always takes place on the third Sunday of June now, that date was actually a compromise after the original turned out to be unrealistic. Dodd's goal was for the holiday to be observed on June 5th to land on her father's birthday, but when the mayor of Spokane and local churches asked for more time to prepare for all the festivities involved, it was moved to the third Sunday in June, where it remains today. Officially, the first Father's Day celebration took place on June 19, 1910.

Roses were originally a big part of the Father's Day celebration.

The first Father's Day included a church service where daughters would hand red roses to their fathers during the mass. The roses were also pinned onto the clothing of children to further honor their fathers, red roses for a still-living father and a white rose for the deceased. Dodd also brought roses and gifts to any father in the community who was unable to make it to the service. This gave birth to the now-nearly-forgotten tradition of roses as the customary flower of Father's Day.

Not everyone was happy with the idea of making Mother's Day and Father's Day separate holidays.

In the 1920s and 1930s, there was a movement to get rid of Mother's Day and the burgeoning Father's Day celebrations and instead join the two holidays as a unified Parents' Day. Robert Spere, a philanthropist and children's radio entertainer, saw the holidays as a "division of respect and affection" for parents, especially during a time when Father's Day hadn't officially been recognized nationwide." We should all have love for dads and mothers every day, but Parents' Day on the second Sunday in May is a reminder that both parents should be loved and respected together," Spere told *The New York Times* in 1931. The movement died out in the 1940s, but if it had gone through, we'd all be celebrating Parents' Day every year with the slogan, "A kiss for mother, a hug for dad."
