Commissioned Host Gifts for IPP 35 (Designed by Robert Yarger & Neil Hutchison.)

Tinker Puzzle Boxes are designed and handcrafted by artists Robert Yarger and Neil Hutchison in collaboration. The project took 8 months to compete, with both designers modifying and shipping various parts back and forth (in whatever spare time they could muster) between other projects

Puzzleboxes require a minimum of 49 steps to discover its 3 secret compartments, and require the discovery and assembly of mechanical tools along the way. They measure 11 " x 8" x 7",



weigh 7 lbs, and come with their own 15-page, fully-illustrated solution book.



Tinker Puzzleboxes are extremely limited in production. Originally, only 2 puzzles, (*crafted from wenge, leopardwood*, & *maple*) were commissioned as host gifts. But it soon became apparent that the scope of such an extensive project would quickly exceed the allotted budget, so another 10 versions (*crafted from walnut, rosewood & maple*) were additionally produced to cover production costs. Aside from these 12 puzzles, no additional versions will ever be made.
