### Bike Numbers

Your bike MUST have the proper numbers on all three plates and be readable or you may not be scored.

### Age Classes

Your age as of October 11, 2020 will determine your age class eligibility.

### No Jump Drum/Disc

No jump means no clearing jumps. You cannot clear a double, triple or tabletop. If jump is a single you can jump to flat ground. If tabletop you can jump onto top but not to the downside. Violating this rule will get you disqualified for that race.

### Palmetto Motorsport - Kawasaki trailman class

Trailman class consists of bikes such as Kawasaki KLX, Honda XR and CRF (trail version, not moto), Yamaha TTR, Suzuki DR-Z and any other brand that fits the criteria of 230cc or less (4 stroke) and a maximum of 9.5" of front suspension travel. The skill levels accepted will be beginner and C.

### Pit Bike class

Bike modifications will be inspected by the "visual inspection". Meaning, no fancy BBR frames and/or suspension that drives cost too high. Exhaust, peg location, bars and seat mods are ok. Working with stock suspension would be ok. Maximum engine size 110cc.
