LOVE Network Trees Spread Joy December 1 Gifts Need to be at the Trees

The Iowa County LOVE Network is preparing to share the joy of the holiday season and their work is much needed as many in Iowa County are experiencing hardship.

There will be 70 to 80 gift tags on the trees located in the Amana Family Practice Clinic and the Amana Pharmacy this year, reports Carmen Grimm, a LOVE Network volunteer. Also please note that the gifts should be returned to the tree before Monday, December 1.

December 1 all of the gifts will be collected for distribution before Christmas.

If you are unfamiliar with the LOVE Network trees. Here's how it works. Christmas trees are placed at the Amana Family Practice Clinic, the Amana Pharmacy, First Trust and Savings Bank, Williamsburg, Mercy Family Medicine of Williamsburg and various churches. Each tree has many gift tags on it. In October professional social service and health providers hand out applications for assistance. The family or individual applies and indicates what they need most. These are collected and gift tags created for the trees. Each gift tag shows the age, gender and item requested with information such as the size needed. For example a gift tag might read: hooded sweatshirt for boy. Children's size x-large or adult


