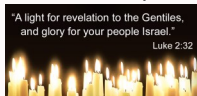


Council of Catholic Women (CCW) upcoming events:

~ English Language Arts: 80% & Math: 67%
- For the current 2025-2026 academic year 90% of our students are reading at or above grade level with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension. We beat our own standards! We are very proud of our students!**
