Autism Center for Children Expands into West Cobb / Paulding County with New Office

Practice Responds to Exceptional Demand for its Renowned Treatment for Toddlers by Opening its Second Location in North Atlanta

Woodstock, GA – November 26, 2018 – Autism Center for Children, a practice advancing early diagnosis and treatment of autism in toddlers, today announced the opening of its second location, in response to particularly strong demand from Cobb and Paulding Counties. The new facility features a large conference and event area, four dedicated toilet training areas, and numerous treatment rooms and facilities. It is conveniently located midway between Marietta and Dallas at 5041 Dallas Highway, Suite 1-D, Powder Springs, Georgia, 30127. This new office will complement the Center’s current location in Woodstock, at 575 and Highway 92. It is set to open Monday, December 3, 2018 and will be staffed with the Autism Center for Children’s expert BCBA and RBT therapists.

The new West Cobb / Paulding location will initially offer a limited number of openings for immediate treatment of toddlers recently diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD). In addition to accepting insurance including Aetna, Cigna and more, both Centers now also accept Private (Self) Pay options for treatment services. Dr. Crittendon – licensed clinical psychologist, Ph.D., BCBA-D, and the head of the Autism Center for Children – outlines the following parameters for its new office openings for treatment:

- Immediate December 2018 openings for our 5-star-rated intensive ABA treatment
- Up to 35 hours of therapy per child per week available (where deemed medically necessary based upon the individual child’s needs)
- Toddlers 15 to 24 months who have been recently diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder
- Families living within a convenient 15 mile radius of the new office, including those in Austell, Dallas, Hiram, Kennesaw, Lithia Springs, Powder Springs, Mableton, Marietta and Smyrna



- Referrals from Babies Can't Wait and from leading pediatricians including Cobb Pediatrics, Healthy Steps Pediatrics, and more than a dozen others located in that same service radius
