

**ORDINANCE NO. 88-6**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS,  
ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS, WORKERS AND  
MECHANICS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS OF SAID VILLAGE**

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being Section 39s-1 through 39s-12, Chapter 48, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Village employed in performing construction of public works, for said Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Chapin is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Morgan County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June, 1988. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

**SECTION 2:** Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Chapin to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LABOR ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT OF PUBLIC WORKERS IN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Act for regulation of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public work by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one or more of such public bodies, approved June 22, 1941, as amended, Chapter 52a-1 through 52a-5, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1935, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Board of Trustees of the Illinois State Board of Laborers, Mechanics and other Workers in the Public Service be organized in conformity with the provisions of said Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State of Illinois to provide for the regulation of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public work by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one or more of such public bodies, approved June 22, 1941, as amended, Chapter 52a-1 through 52a-5, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1935, and

SECTION 1: To the extent not amended by the Act for regulation of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public work by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one or more of such public bodies, approved June 22, 1941, as amended, Chapter 52a-1 through 52a-5, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1935, and in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Board of Trustees in the State of Illinois, approved June 22, 1941, as amended, Chapter 52a-1 through 52a-5, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1935, and to be the same as the provisions of the Act for regulation of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public work by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one or more of such public bodies, approved June 22, 1941, as amended, Chapter 52a-1 through 52a-5, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1935, and the definition of any term appearing in the Ordinance which has been amended by the Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply and amend the provisions of any law or ordinance relating to any work or employment except public works construction of the State of Illinois to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.


**SECTION 3:** The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this Village, this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

**SECTION 4:** The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

**SECTION 5:** The Village Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

**SECTION 6:** The Village Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.




