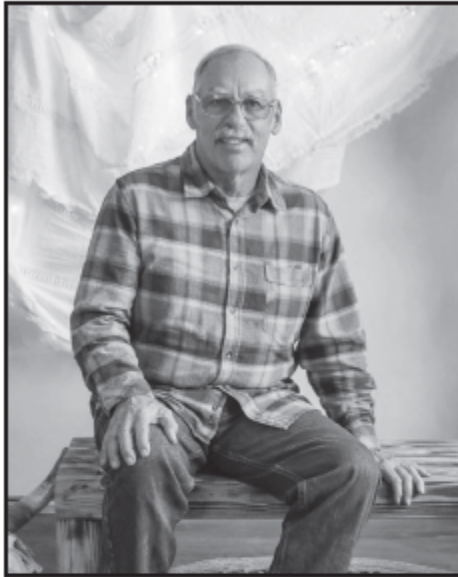


*Terry L. Mills*
