

Intersections Wood Gallery & Studio Membership Agreement

The Intersections Wood Gallery & Studio ("Intersections") is a place for creative, social experimentation in the fields of technology, craft, science and media.

Membership in Intersections requires a commitment to the ideals and aims of Intersections, respect and co-operation with other members, a monetary commitment to the upkeep and improvement of Intersections, and agreement with the Constitution of Intersections.

Membership grants a right to take part in Intersections activities, to share in Intersections resources, and to vote at General Meetings of the membership.

By signing this document, witnessed and sponsored by two fellow existing members, you agree:

1. That you have read and agree with the terms of Intersections Constitution, and that you agree to follow the guidelines and rules for Intersections.
2. That you will respect likewise any future amendments to the Constitution or rules as made by the membership by due process, irrespective of your personal votes or opinions on the matter. You further agree and understand that the rules may be changed or added to from time to time and you agree to abide by such future rules.
3. That you will pay yearly membership dues, and that you understand these dues may change from time to time.
4. That you will pay \$60 when joining.
5. That your participation in Intersections is a commitment to be a respectful and respectable member, and that you will not participate in any discrimination, insult, harm or disparagement against another member.
6. That you will help in the manual upkeep of Intersections and its equipment.
7. That you will not compromise the security or comfort of Intersections, and you will not invite anyone with a known intention to do so. You agree that you are responsible for all guests brought into Intersections Gallery.
8. That you understand the risks in using the workshop tools, and take responsibility for your own safety and well-being in Intersections studio.
9. That any tools listed by Intersections as 'High Risk' will require completion of a Use and Safety Course before you use them.
10. You will not smoke or use any illegal drugs on the premises. NO alcohol in Intersections Studio.
11. While not at the workshop, you will confine your belongs to your allocated storage space.
12. You understand that your membership may be terminated at any time for any reason. If your membership is terminated there will be no reimbursement of any funds.
