Kingdom Alive Soccer Association - KASA



<u>KASA</u> is a faith-based non-profit organization providing all levels of instruction/play for youth soccer. This includes programs for age groups U6 through High School. KASA offers year-round programs, including winter Futsal-style indoor soccer. We hold girls and boys seasonal tournaments. We collaborate with college men's/women's soccer programs to offer camps/clinics in Marion. KASA can provide scholarships to those needing financial assistance.

Age Brackets and Leagues

KASA is registering players for Spring 2023 teams. Ohio and national standards set the soccer year at August 1—July 31; so <u>Spring</u> will be the 2nd half of soccer year 2022/2023. Players' *natural* age brackets are determined like this: take the <u>latter year</u> of the soccer year (2023); now subtract the player's birth year. For example, a player born in 2013 is age bracket U10 for this soccer year (2023 – 2013 = 10). For several reasons, KASA typically sponsors *youth* teams only in age brackets U6, U8, U10, U12, U15, and U18. So out of necessity some players have to "play up". Players are restricted from playing up more than 2 age brackets – *and we must always take safety and other factors into consideration*. Players are never allowed to "play down". U6 is born 2017 or later; U8 means born 2015 or later; U10 is for those born 2013 or later; U12 means born 2011 or later. Players born 2010 – 2009 usually fit into the U15/Middle School program. Players born 2008 or earlier typically are in our High School leagues. There are some differences/exceptions at the Middle School and High School levels.

- Heart of Ohio Youth Soccer Association (HOYSA) provides co-ed recreational level soccer for U6, U8, U10 & U12 age bracket players. (Cardington, Mount Vernon & Centerburg). Many KASA kids play here.
- Middle School Soccer Association (MSSA) is a Central Ohio *recreational* soccer program for 6th-8th grade players. There are co-ed, all-boys, and all-girls teams. While MSSA is *recreational*, there are varying levels of competition (A, B, C, D, etc.). KASA has had multiple <u>championship</u> MSSA teams.
- Ohio Soccer Association Developmental League/Buckeye Premier Youth Soccer League offer competitive
 play; as does Central Ohio Premier League. Competitive teams are all-girls/all-boys. For competitive
 teams, players are selected by invitation, then tryout or evaluation.

General Information

- 1. Regular season is 6 10 games beginning late-March to early-April; games run late-May to early-June. HOYSA U6, U8, U10, & U12 games <u>usually</u> are Saturdays only. MSSA games are <u>typically</u> Thursday & Saturdays for Boys; and Wednesdays and Saturdays for Girls. Competitive team schedules are dependent upon leagues and opponents. Practice days/times are set by the coaches.
- 2. Most programs have season-end tournaments. Competitive teams may also play non-league tournaments.
