ORDINANCE NO. 611

E. F. ACUFF, MAYOR

An ordinance in relation to side-walks in the city of Garnett, Kansas

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1. That a side-walk be constructed of cement, ^{and maintained} on along the north side of block fifteen (15) ^{where walks have not been heretofore constructed} and on along the south side of block fifty eight (58) and block fifty-nine (59) in the city of Garnett, Kansas; ^{and} on along the north side of lot six (6) in Chapions addition to the city of Garnett, Kansas; ^{and} on along the north side of lots one (1) two (2) three (3) and four (4) and the west eleven (11) rods of lot five (5) in Nichols addition to the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 2. That the side-walks required to be built in section one (1) of this ordinance shall be constructed not less than four (4) feet in width and under the supervision and direction of the commissioner of streets and alleys, and in accordance to the specifications and plans of the city engineer in the city of Garnett, Kansas, on or before two months from and after taking effect of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after ten days from its passage by the board of commissioners and approved by the mayor.
