1. The Youth Cup is open to all USBC certified youth bowlers in good standing under the age of 18 as of August 1, 2024
2. Format: This is a scratch tournament with five games of qualifying. The field will be cut into a bracketed format. The number of athletes moving into brackets will be based on entries. The five-game pinfall will be dropped, and the bowlers will then bowl a two-game match play with the highest pinfall advancing. Each round will be conducted this way until an eventual champion is crowned.
3. Entry fee will be \$65. Lineage - \$20, Expenses \$5.00 and \$40.00 for scholarship dollars. There will be a \$2000 additional added prize money. All prize monies will be returned 100%
4. A minimum of 1 out of 6 will receive scholarship money.
5. New for 2025- A \$1,000 bonus for shooting a 300 will be added. The number of 300's rolled will split the \$1,000 prize. If no 300 then prize will not be paid out.
6. No entry will be accepted without payment
7. Walk-in entries (day of tournament) will be allowed subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be subject to an additional \$10 late processing fee which will be added into the prize fund.
8. Dress Code: T-shirts, sweatshirts, and tank tops are not allowed. Girls are allowed to wear dress shorts, skorts or skirts. Boys must wear dress pants or dress shorts. No apparel may be worn with reference to illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco or use of obscenities or offensive content.
9. Tie Breaker- in the event of a tie for the final advancing position in any round of the tournament, the tie will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll off.
10. Lane Breakdowns – Contact the front desk at the center to correct/repair any lane breakdown or deadwood. Tournament Management has the right to move bowlers on a broken pair to an unused working pair if conditions warrant.
11. Disputes – Only a participating bowler may approach a tournament manager to discuss alleged rules violations
12. The Tournament Manager has the final decision with any rules not covered above.
