**INDUSTRY NEWS**: Sauz raised \$12M led by CAVU Consumer Partner. Pickle Juice, anti-cramping functional beverage brand, announced a strategic growth investment from Azalea Capital. Coco Robotics, sidewalk delivery robots, raised \$80M from Sam Altman, Pelion Venture Partners, Offline Ventures & others. Tastewise, GenAl platform to turn data & trends into actionable marketing & commercial strategies, raised \$72M led by TELUS Global Ventures, with

participation from Disruptive AI, Peakbridge Capital, Duo Partners & PICO Venture Partners. In the UK, RootWave raised \$15M for its high-frequency electrical weed control technology led by Clay Capital with participation from Agri Investment Fund, Xinomavro Ventures, V-Bio Ventures, Rabo Ventures, PYMWYMIC & private investors; the round included \$3M in debt funding from Innovate UK. In Spain, Voltrac, autonomous electric tractors, raised €2M with FoodLabs & Antler involved. In the Netherlands, Tebi, small hospitality business operating system, raised €30M led by CapitalG with Index Ventures involved. Also, Netherlands-based Aquablu, workplace hydration through tech-enabled dispensers, raised €7M. Vegdog, vegan dog food & supplements, raised €9M led by ECBF VC & Green Generation Fund. PFx Biotech closed a €2.5M round to scale fermentation-derived human milk proteins; the round was led by Buenavista Equity Partners, with participation from EIT Food & Beta Capital. Verlinvest & Mistral Equity Partners, owners Insomnia Cookies, bought out Krispy Kreme's minority stake in the fresh-baked cookie chain & online store for \$75M in cash. Triton Beverage Group acquired Cape Cod Beer. Refresco acquired Telemark Kildevann, a Norwegian soft drink & bottled water producer. DoorDash acquired ad tech platform Symbiosys for \$175M. PE firm HC Private Investments launched Artisan Bakery, a bakery platform to acquire baked snacks, desserts & bake goods manufacturers. Brazil's competition regulator approved the proposed merger between meat giants Marfria Global Foods & BRF. Maple Leaf Foods approved the spin-off of their pork segment. JBS began its listing on the NYSE on June 13. From Agfunder using Pitchbook data, Food Tech investment fell significantly in 1st QTR, down 36.7% in capital outlays & nearly 50% YOY. Cibus, agricultural biotechnology gene editing technologies company, raised \$27.5M in a public offering. In the UK, discounter Poundland was acquired out of administration for £1 by Gorden Brothers (former owners of Laura Ashley) with plans to invest £108M to revitalize the retailer. Confluence Genetics (an Anheuser Busch family office) acquired seed development company Benson Hill out of Chapter 11.

JM Smucker missed 4<sup>th</sup> QTR expectations as Hostess slumped; the stock fell to a 52-week low on a dismal full year outlook. UNFI reported YOY performance improvements for the 3<sup>rd</sup> QTR. UNFI will end its distribution relationship with Key Foods in New York, a \$1B dollar a year business impacting UNFI's future revenue. Lifeway gave investors an update two months into 2<sup>nd</sup> QTR that sales are up significantly with a wider distribution.

Amazon is moving Whole Foods leadership in house. Tops Market & Uncle Giuseppe's both opened new stores in New York state. T&T Supermarkets will open its second store in Southern California in Chino Hills, set to open in Fall 2026. Costco will provide earlier shopping hours for executive members. Dollar General reported success from last year's reduction of 1000 SKUs & is planning to reduce more SKUs this year. Walmart expanded its drone delivery partnership with Wing to Atlanta, Charlotte, Houston, Orlando & Tampa. Walmart attempted to quickly distance themselves from heiress Christy Walton who is funding & promoting the national day of violence & terror on June 14. We Store Frozen, cold storage & logistics, signed a \$15M, three-year agreement for 7K frozen storage pallet positions with HEB & Walmart. Kodiak Cakes will introduce two products: trail bars with protein & frozen breakfast sandwiches. Noosa will add six yogurt flavors with premium toppings. Cleveland Kitchen has launched fermented singleserve Pickle Bites in three flavors. LesserEvil will introduce organic cheese snacks, Cheezmos, in two flavors. Cheez-It will partner with Wendy's on a Baconators snack. Nature's Path launched oat-based snacks for toddlers. Califia Farms added a 10g protein latte to its line up. One Brands & Hershey will collaborate on – wait for it – a protein bar (who would have guessed)! Molson Coors partnered with beauty brand Eos on a Blue Moon Valencia orange flavored lip balm. Mochi brand Bubbies launched a line of Mini Ice Cream Cookie Sandwiches in two flavors: Key Lime Pie & Strawberry Shortcake. CAULIPOWER's gluten-free cauliflower crust pizza is available on select pizzas at 255 Pizza Hut locations across eight states as part of a limited-time test. John Soules Foods, prepared meat products, will rebrand as Soules Foods. Puratos, in collaboration with AMF Bakery Systems, opened a new pilot innovation bakery plant at its USA headquarters in New Jersey. Del Monte Foods closed a processing plant & two warehouses in Yakima, WA, that produce & store fruits. PepsiCo shut down manufacturing operations at a Frito-Lay plant in Rancho Cucamonga; the warehouse, distribution & transportation employees will continue to operate at the location. Due to the termination of the Key Foods relationship, UNFI will close in Allentown, PA, facility opened to support the business. Bakery Barn, a maker of protein-centric baked foods, cookies, brownies & bars, will close its manufacturing facility in Pleasant Hills, PA. Olymel, will expand its Trois-Rivières, Quebec pork & poultry plant with a C\$142M investment. PepsiCo will invest \$30M in agriculture initiatives by 2030. Wayne-Sanderson Farms donated \$2M to update the UGA poultry science building. In Europe, Siemens is partnering with Entocycle to digitalize & scale its insect farming capabilities. In Minnesota, 26 employees at a Pilgrim's Pride plant were sent to the hospital following the spill of a sanitizing chemical. UNFI reported disrupted operations & distribution due to a cyberattack. More than 100 illegal aliens were arrested at Green Valley Foods in Nebraska. Starbucks will speed up its enhanced staffing model rollout & will test a new protein drink. August Egg out of Hilmar, CA recalled 1.7M dozen brown cage-free & brown certified-organic eggs due to salmonella; the eggs were sold in 17 states. The FDA approved lab-grown fake salmon made by Wildtype. Target & Campbell dropped their claims against poultry processor Mar-Jac in a decade old broiler price-fixing antitrust lawsuit. Kroger is facing class action suits in several states over incorrect & out-of-date price tags. A woman stole \$375K from Perdue in Perry, GA, using a 'ghost employee' scheme; to quote George & Ira Gershwin, "Nice work if you can get it!"

From *Brick Meets Click/Mercatus*, online grocery sales jumped 27% in May YOY, with delivery driving the change. From *Circana*, nearly half of all consumers report snacking three times a day. The *IDFA* reported that the dairy industry supports 3M USA jobs, \$198B in wages & makes an economic impact totaling close to \$780B. From *NIQ*, globally, 70% of respondents regularly engage in exercise, nutrition tracking or monitoring health metrics; 55% are willing to spend more than \$100 per month on total wellness. Peruvian avocado exports are projected to be 30% higher this season with a 75% increase in exports to the USA. *Circana* reports little impact to food prices from tariffs. Fresh produce prices shrunk 0.5% in May.

MARKET NEWS: Markets lower on the week, falling Friday as Israel, patient for 46 years, stood up for world peace by attacking nuclear sites in Iran - you know, the country that funds terror & likes to chant "Death to Israel" & "Death to America." The CPI, Core CPI, Producers Price Index & core PPI came in lower than expected in May & YOY inflation was slightly lower, causing even the political shills in the media to admit tariffs have not caused inflation! The University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment beat expectations by 15% as consumers see inflation lower & little impact from tariffs. Market analysts are favoring two rate cuts this year. The World Bank agreed with the President that the USA has been unfairly treated as a trade partner & urged countries to work with the USA to create mutual success agreements.
