ENTRY RULES

- Enter in one class only and circle number desired on entry form. Parade Committee has the option to place entry in correct class if entered incorrectly. It is very important that we receive pages 5 and 6 of the entry packet at the Fair Office before the deadline.
- All entrants will obtain their parade entry number from Parade Committee members located at Frontier Village (Hayfork Discount Market) parking lot at 8:00 am, Sunday August 2nd. <u>Judging starts at 8:30 a.m. promptly</u>. Late arrivals might not be judged!
- This year we will be judging for BEST IN PARADE from all division winners. Each division winner will be picked from 1st place winners in each class. The Best in Parade winner will receive a rosette, trophy and \$100.
- All participants will form-up at Frontier Valley (Hayfork Discount Market) Parking lot by entry number after obtaining their number. State approximate length of truck and/or float on entry form.
- Parade route from Frontier Village, along Hwy 3 to the Trinity County Fairgrounds Dining Hall Parking Lot
- Parade participants will be judged at Frontier Village before the parade begins and then again when they pass the Judges at the Postal Square (downtown) the winner will be announced and awarded at the end of the parade at the Trinity County Fairgrounds. During the parade participants will be announced as they pass the postal square.
- VEHICLE CLASSES 6 & 7 PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO BREAKING OF TRACTION OR EXCESSIVE LOUD NOISE OR ENTRY WILL BE ELIMINATED.
- Last minute entries may participate in the parade but will not be judged.
- CHILDREN 10 & UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED ON PARADE ROUTE BY AN ADULT.
- All decisions of the judges are final!
