Delmar J. "Jim" Truemner, age 80 of Pigeon, passed away Thursday, November 12 at Four Seasons Healthcare Center, Bad Axe.

He was born in Kilmanagh on January 3, 1918, the son of the late Eldon and Esther (Otto) Truemner. On September 24, 1938 he was united in marriage to Edna B. Haag in South Bend, Indiana. She preceded him in death on October 11, 1995.
