NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO ADOPT DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS
December 19, 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons in Fannin and Grayson Counties, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Red River Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) will hold a public meeting, accept public comment, and consider adoption of the Desired Future Conditions for the groundwater resources within the District pursuant to Section 36.108(d-4) of the Texas Water Code. The Desired Future Conditions for the District are as follows: District-wide average aquifer drawdown through 2070 of (in feet by aquifer/layer): 204 in Woodbine; 699 in Paluxy; 283 in Glen Rose; 377 in Twin Mountain; 269 in Travis Peak; 304 in Antlers. County-wide average aquifer drawdown through 2070 of (in feet by aquifer/layer): Fannin County - 247 in Woodbine, 688 in Paluxy, 280 in Glen Rose, 372 in Twin Mountain, 269 in Travis Peak, 251 in Antlers; Grayson County – 160 in Woodbine, 922 in Paluxy, 337 in Glen Rose, 417 in Twin Mountain, 348 in Antlers.

The District developed the Desired Future Conditions as required by Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code with the other groundwater conservation districts in Groundwater Management Area 8. The other districts within Groundwater Management Area 8 include: Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District; Clearwater Underground Water Conservation District; Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; North Texas Groundwater Conservation District; Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District; Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District; Saratoga Underground Water Conservation District; Southern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; and Upper Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.

The public meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 19, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. at the District office, located at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, TX 75020. Comments on the Desired Future Conditions may be presented in written or verbal form at the meeting. Written comments may also be submitted prior to the meeting by email at rrgcd@redrivergcd.org, by mail at P.O. Box 1214, Sherman, TX 75091, or by hand-delivery at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, TX 75020.

The District Board of Directors will also hold a regular Board meeting at the same time and place as the public meeting on the Desired Future Conditions. Agenda items for the regular Board meeting include: Call to order, declare meeting open to public and take roll, public comment, approval of minutes, review and approval of monthly invoices, receive monthly financial information, update and possible action on process for the development of Desired Future Conditions, consider and act on compliance and enforcement activities for violation of District Rules, General Manager’s report (update on operational, educational, and other activities of District), rules development, open forum/discussion of new business for future meeting agendas, and adjourn meeting.
