Synopsis:

This workshop covers the topics of the most common medical emergencies or conditions that can happen at any time and any place including the Dental Office including seizures, asthma attack and bronchospasm, angina pectoris, anaphylaxis, hypo and hyperglycemia assessment and treatment are covered at this event. Sudden cardiac arrest and basic life support with AED are included in this course.

Objectives:

- Identify the most common medical emergencies at the dental office.
- Execute a primary clinical assessment of a patient with a potential medical emergency during a dental visit.
- Administer rescue medications indicated for an emergency medical condition.

About the Speaker:

David Pintado, MD, MHA, CCMA

Dr. Pintado is a retired Family Practice physician with a Master's degree in healthcare administration.
