**IV. PROGRAM – Terry Roker, Cheyenne Trade Tokens**

Born in London before WW II. Told about his youth during and following the war. Joined the Navy, then moved to New Zealand. From a Cockney to a Kiwi.... Married Marian and moved to America. Has three books of Trade Tokens – over 800 pages. He has done books on several cities: Laramie, Rocky Ford, CO. He has learned a lot of history through collecting tokens. McDonalds had Big Mac tokens. Others: Plains Hotel, Hoffman House, Capitol Bar, Ed Garrett Cigars, Southside Billiards. Square & Aluminum: Boyd’s Cigar Store and Billiards. Round and white metal: Tom B. Scallop shaped– 4 – PTS and Brass: Home Ranch, Redwood Saloon – first liquor license in Cheyenne – heart shaped. Octagonal Brass – Chief Terminal W & S Casino Bar, Princess Candy Store. Elks Club, James Brothers, Triangle Shape/Aluminum – Metropolitan Hotel; Oval Aluminum – Tivoli-Germania Hall. Colorado and Southern Railroad – first passenger train from Denver in 1910. Moved the Albany Hotel to accommodate the train. Oval/Brass – The Becker Hotel. Round and made of brass – coins. And many, many more....

Lion Gail won wind chime and UW cap.


