February 4, 2019

The Town Council met February 4, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Thorsby Municipal Annex Building.

Mayor Hight called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m. Police Chief Barnett gave the invocation.

Mayor Hight asked for approval of the Council Minutes from January 22, 2019.

Council Member Benson moved to approve the Council Minutes from January 22, 2019 as presented. Council Member Collins seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Crumpton, Collins, Benson and Chapman.

New Business

Department Heads

Police Chief Barnett reported to the Council that the Tahoe that was in a wreck was a total loss and that the Town would be keeping it for parts that can be used on a new one.

Chief Barnett reported that he has Patrick Young that has applied for the School Resource Officer position. Chief asked the Council about starting him out at \$17.00 an hour that would be less than what the other officer was making so it would be within the budget.

Council Member Chapman moved to approve to hire Patrick Young for the SRO position starting him out at \$17.00. Council Member Collins seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Crumpton, Collins, Benson and Chapman.

Fire Chief Conner reported that they had the Drill Field classroom updated and 2 burn rooms built. He stated he had 12 that has signed up for the classes.

Fire Chief Conner also reported that the Sheriff has approved the County Arson Task Force and that the Town would have to sign a contract and if everything goes a planned it would start up in March.

Fire Chief Conner showed the Council the Fire Departments new patch for their uniforms, he stated that this is the first patch that the department has ever had.

Terry Jackson reported on a few leaks they had last week and the repair on the ditch on Franklin St.

Council Member Littleton asked about the Fiber Optic line that is being put in on Hwy 31. Terry reported that he had met with them last week they are starting at Co Rd 29 and Hwy 31 and will cross over at Franklin St. and on to Iowa.

Council Member Crumpton asked Terry if he could clean the Welcome to Thorsby signs. Terry stated he would.

Council Member Littleton moved to approve transfer of funds, and bills for February 4, 2019. Council Member Crumpton seconded the motion. The motion carried with the votes being as follow: Yeas: Council Member Littleton, Crumpton, Benson, Collins and Chapman.
