Pastoral Reflection

As I write this reflection on the Monday before Christmas, I'm sitting in Church with about 30 people around me setting up the Nativity scene and decorating for Christmas. There's a little debate on where exactly to place things, but overall, it is a wonderful spirit of cooperation and community. So, it's appropriate that by the time this is published, it will be the Feast of the Holy Family, which is also a celebration of family, not just the family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, but all our families, including the family we call the parish of St. Pius X. This feast is a reminder that God chose to come to us within a human family that in many ways is like any family you might encounter today. They had the challenges of raising and protecting a child, making a living, getting along with in-laws and relatives, paying taxes, and working together with their neighbors. But the family of Jesus reminds us that we belong to a larger family. We are never truly alone as Catholics. We belong to a parish, a diocese, and, in fact, a world-wide Church. As the Christmas decorations start to take shape around me, I'm reminded of this parish family and the beauty of the Body of Christ to which we all belong.
