

ORDINANCE NO. 16-1975

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE  
NUMBERED 1975-13 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE  
FIXING RATES AND CHARGES TO BE COLLECTED BY  
THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA, FROM THE OWNERS  
OF PROPERTY SERVED BY THE SEWAGE WORKS OF SAID TOWN  
AND OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED  
THEREWITH"

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF  
CLOVERDALE, INDIANA:

Section 2. Subparagraph (c) is amended to read as follows:

"(c) Where meters larger than 5/8 and 3/4 inch are in-  
stalled, the following minimum charges shall apply:

| <u>Size of Water Meter</u> | <u>Minimum Charge per Month</u> |
|----------------------------|---------------------------------|
| 1 inch meter               | \$6.50                          |
| 1 1/4 inch meter           | 8.50                            |
| 1 1/2 inch meter           | 12.50                           |
| 2 inch meter               | 21.50                           |
| 3 inch meter               | 40.00                           |
| 4 inch meter               | 66.50                           |

Provided, however, that the minimum charge for a user where  
the water usage is not totally metered shall be \$4.50 per  
month".

All other provisions of this ordinance remain the same.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

Sec. 8. No unauthorized person shall maliciously, willfully or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure, appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the sewage works. Any person violating this provision shall be held liable for any damages caused any part of the sewage works.

Sec. 9. The Superintendent, Inspector, and other duly authorized employees of the Town bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to enter upon all properties for the purpose of inspection, observation, measurement, sampling, and testing, in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Sec. 10. (a) Any person found to be violating any provision of this ordinance except Sec. 8 shall be served by the Town with written notice stating the nature of the violation and providing a reasonable time limit for the satisfactory correction thereof. The offender shall, within the period of time stated in such notice, permanently cease all violations.

(b) Any person who shall continue any violation beyond the time limit provided for in Sec. 10(a) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding ten dollars (\$10) for each violation. Each day in which any such violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

(c) Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall become liable to the Town for any expense, loss or damage occasioned the Town by reason of such violation.

Sec. 11. (a) The Town has been issued National Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit No. IN0022616 by the Environmental Protection Agency governing discharge from a publicly owned treatment works. The provisions contained in this Ordinance are set forth in accordance with the conditions relative to the Permit and directives of the Environmental Protection Agency.

(b) Reference is made to two other Ordinances of the Town, Ordinance No. 1975-03, governing user charges to be made by the Town for use of the Sewage Works and Ordinance No. 1975-10, providing for a system of industrial user

recovery from the industrial users of the sewage works. Charges to the users of the sewage works based on excess strength of waste shall result from provisions of these two ordinances.

Sec. 12. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Sec. 13. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
