Ordinance No 163

An Ordinance to prohibit the sale of Cigarettes & Cigarette paper within the Corporate limits of the City of Garnett

Whereas; The use of Cigarettes & the smoking of tobacco wrapped in paper prepared for that purpose and ~~commonly~~ commonly known as Cigarette paper, has become so prevalent among the young men & boys of this City as to be injurious to them, noxious to others, and to impair the usefulness and impede the progress of the Public Schools. And whereas the present law regulating the sale of these articles has proven to be insufficient for the adequate protection of the public from the aforesaid and other vicious influences caused by the use of said articles.

Now therefore Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilman of the City

~~Section 1. Any person who shall within the Corporate limits of this city, sell, barter, or by any shift or device intended as a violation of this ordinance, give away or dispose of any Cigarettes or any paper commonly known as Cigarette paper, shall upon~~

Sec. 1. Any person who shall within the corporate limits of this city, sell, barter, or by any shift or device intended as a violation of this ordinance, give away, or dispose of any cigarettes, or any paper commonly known as cigarette ^{papers}, shall upon conviction thereof be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished ~~by a fine~~ for the first offense by a fine of not less than Ten (\$10⁰⁰) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100⁰⁰) Dollars ~~or by imprisonment in the city jail for less than Ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment, and for the second and every subsequent offense by both such fine ^{together with} imprisonment not less than Ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days in the city jail.~~
