I. PURPOSE

It is the purpose of this policy to state NWSISD's role in meeting the state and federal testing requirements.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the responsibility of NWSISD member school districts to administer all tests required by Minnesota Statutes and federal regulations. NWSISD will work with its member school districts to ensure NWSISD programs and activities do not conflict or interfere with the administration of these tests.
