HIGH POINT RULES

High Point awards based on **one horse/one rider combination**. If a tie, the Showmanship class is the tiebreaker.

Overall High Points are the combined English and Western High Point Totals

High Point tabulation is a scale based on the number of horses in the class. 1 point given for entering a class if not placed in the class.

The following classes will be counted for High Point Awards:

17 & Under: 4, 8, 11, 13, 16, 18, 22, 28, 31, 34, 37, 42 18 & Over: 5, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 23, 29, 31, 35, 37, 44

W/T/J 10 & under: 1, 7, 20, 27, 41 W/T/J Open: 2, 11, 21, 25, 31, 42, 46

English Horse: 8 or 9, 11, 13 or 14, 16, 18, 19, 21, 22 or 23, 25, 26 Western Horse: 28 or 29, 31, 34 or 35, 37, 40, 42, 43 or 44, 46, 47

Novice Rider: 3, 10, 15, 24, 30, 36, 45

GENERAL RULES

- ALL MANAGEMENT DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- NO REFUND WITHOUT VETERINARIAN DOCUMENTATION.
- ASTM/SEI HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR RIDERS 17 AND UNDER AND MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED ON NVHA GROUNDS. WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED
- Boots, collared shirts, long sleeves and long pants are required in all events (show clothes optional).
- Lead Line is walk only may not cross enter in any other class
- Walk/Trot/Jog 10 & Under may not cross enter in canter/lope classes
- To qualify for Walk/Trot/Jog Open High Point may not cross enter in canter/lope classes
- All Riders under 16 years of age must have adult supervision
- Management reserves the right to cancel, split or combine classes.
- Management or Judges Decision is final.
- Excessive schooling, inhumane treatment or unacceptable behavior by participants will be subject to review by show committee and may result in dismissal from the show grounds.
- Horses that are out of control will be excused from the arena.
- Stallion handlers must be 18 years or older.
- Age of riders as of January 1, 2018.
- Green Horse First or second year showing in that division.
- Novice Rider Not to have won 5 blue ribbons in that division.
