Before we get started I want to pray a prayer over all of you that Paul prayed over the church in Ephesus. "For this reason I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge-that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God." (Ephesians 3:14-19)

AND all those things WILL be given to you as wall." There again is His promise for us when we seek, it "will be given to you". I love the way the Message translation shares 1 Peter 2:2-3, "You've had a taste of God. Now. like infants at the breast, drink deep of God's pure kindness. Then you'll grow up mature and whole in God." I keep bringing this up because it's so important for us to know the things that God has already promised us in His Word. So here again, look at the word "you'll". That word is a combination of these two words, 'you - will'. Peter here is assuring us of another one of God's promises. That when we drink of His pure milk (Word) "you WILL grow up mature and whole in God." Hallelujah!!

Looking back over these nearly 12 years of walking and doing my best to listen for God I could have NEVER imagined the life and experiences that I have with Him today. All that we accomplish on this journey/adventure with Jesus lies in our obedience to listen and follow His Spirit's direction and ALL we do is for His glory. Again, let's listen to Paul in *Ephesians 3:20-21*, "Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen." And finding His direction for my life, and yours, it ALL begins by making the conscious decision to ask Jesus to be the Lord of our life. Without a doubt it has been the very best decision I have ever made! But truth be told ... we don't make that decision on our own. It's Holy Spirit that comes to each and every one of us imparting revelation of this TRUTH inside of us. What we're hearing and feeling begins to shed some light, for some reason, and even make some sort of sense to us. And when we respond, at that point, I like to think that this is possibly our first act of obedience to hear and obey God's direction and purpose for our lives. Up unto that point we are going through life doing things in our own power and might and many times wondering, "Is this all there is to my life?"It's when and ONLY when we hear this invita-

tion and receive Jesus, the One Holy Spirit is speaking to our innermost parts about, that we can/do begin to walk in this newness with purpose.

So many times, when we make this decision, if we don't see an immediate change we start to listen to the liar and think, "Nothing is happening! I'm still doing the same things I've always done! I thought that I was going to be a new changed person." DON"T THINK THAT YOU ARE THE ONLY ONE THAT'S EVER FELT THAT WAY. The truth is, the change that has already taken place is on the inside of us, we are given a new Spirit. Along with the new Spirit comes a purpose. "Now the One who has fashioned us for this very purpose is God, who has given us the Spirit as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come." (2 Corinthians 5:5)

The liar wants you to get discouraged and quit before you see what God is doing in you and the direction He has for you. Your enemy, the thief, does NOT want you to get hold of the purpose that God has already set for you to accomplish. Jesus Himself tells us, in John 10:10 (Message), "A third is only there to steel and fall and destroy. I came so they can have real and eternal life, more and leater life than they ever dramad of." The Apostle Paul dealt with these very same issues himself. Listen, "I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do-this I keep on doing. Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it." (Romans 7:15-20) Folks we too still have a sin nature that doesn't want to come into line with our new born again spirits. But keep coming it gets better!

I remember the first time I read this. I thought, "This Paul guy isn't going to take any responsibility for his actions." But later on I seen the truth in what he was saying. Paul knew that there was a difference between what he occasionally still did and the newness that already took place inside of him. In fact, as we continue down to *Romans 7:24* he even states, "What a wretched man I am!" I don't believe that he was discouraged. Instead I see he was encouraging us. Paul wasn't throwing in the towel and quitting because he still did or said some of the things he used to before Jesus! NO! Then as we continue it seems that he is asking, "Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?" Even though this was a question it was NOT one of confusion. We see this by Paul's next statement, "Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!" Notice that there wasn't a question mark after his next statement. Paul knew the issue was his soul not his spirit and he made it very clear with the exclamation point. Paul had the revelation that he was in Christ and Christ was now living on the inside of him. He also recognized that he still had a lot of things to work on but he didn't have to try to do it on his own. He now had God's Holy Spirit to help him. This should be a revelation for each of us as well. We DON'T have to and we CAN'T do this on our own anyways! We ALL attempted it on our own and NOT one of us achieved that mark. That's why Jesus became our Savior!

Even David, a man who God said was a man after His own heart (*Acts 13:22*), had times of struggling. David had issues just like we do today but he had a revelation that there was a difference between his spirit and his soul. Clearly I can envision David tipping his face downward and speaking inside of himself to tell his soul what was in his spirit, the real him. Listen. "*Praise the LORD, my soul; all my inmost being, praise His holy name. Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all His benefits-who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. The LORD works righteousness and justice for all the oppressed." (<i>Psalm 103:1-6*) Do you feel oppression or depression sometimes? I believe this is great advice for each and every one of us as well. Sometimes we need to 'self talk' and get our souls to line up with what's already in our born again spirits. That's exactly what David was doing.

It's my own personal experience that the more I receive and understand of God's love for me the more I'm compelled to walk away from more and more of the things that I too used to be involved in and even said. This is exactly what Paul went on to say in 2 Corinthians 5:14, "For Christ's love compels us, ..." Directly after this we see by the exclamation point that Paul is still speaking to us with confidence, and in a sense saying 'It's settled!" "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" He continues on assuring us that, "All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them." (2 Corinthians 5:17-19a) Did you just see that? God is NOT the one that keeps bringing up your past or your today failures. Scripture says right there that He is "NOT counting people's sins against them" because we are NOW in Christ! Hallelujah! That's good news right there! I know that I'm repeating myself but I believe this needs to be understood ... Christ's love compels us and will propel us and the enemy doesn't want us to accomplish what God has for us to do so he comes at us with discouragement that "There isn't any real change. You're still doing the same things." But keep coming because it does get better!

Let's get back to purpose. Believe me when I tell you that there have been countless opportunities for me to get discour

aged over the years and question, for a minute, if I was on the right path. Straight up, I am no different from any of you that are reading this. I've never questioned my following Jesus but sometimes when it has gotten rough I've went to God about the direction. I've come to realize that those are healthy times because I'm not just running off and doing something that I could possibly achieve on my own. This doesn't mean that we stop at every bump in the road and be freaked out. As long as we're following God His Spirit inside of us will help us correct our direction. So with this being said I guess it's time to ask the question, "How many of you are convinced without a shadow of a doubt that you are following His will and purpose for your lives?" Then keep coming it's already better!

Leaving the world I was so stuck in and giving my heart and life to Jesus was a completely new experience. I was having what I first thought were weird feelings and literal directions. I wasn't hearing an audible voice but it seemed as though I was hearing something inside of me and that was sort of freaky. As weird as it seemed I was ALL in. Several different times a few of us would pray as we were in the car asking God to direct us to where He could use us for that day. We already had plans to do certain things but it never failed that we would end up somewhere and walk right in to what we had asked God to do with us. Even though we all were believing God to do this, when we prayed, it really had us in 'WOW' when it did. The people we ran into were just as amazed as we were that God had directed us their way, in perfect timing. Those times were such great faith boosters and actually taught me early on that God IS ALWAYS directing our path. We just have to listen and obey even if it does seem weird or crazy. I wasn't sure where all of these 'events' were leading me but for sure I wanted to go! Somehow I always knew there was a purpose in where I was going and it excited me to leave the house then ... and it still does. It seemed at first like I had stumbled and landed in such a great place, like being in a bubble, but I soon realized that this was His plan for my life. I've since learned that when I immerse myself in spending quality time with God, on the way, He always gives me even more direction. Not always crystal clear but it is direction.

Even though I just said that it 'seemed like' I had stumbled and landed in 'this part' of my purpose, I now know that finding His purpose doesn't happen like that. We set ourselves up and think to ourselves, "Every other time when things were this great the bottom always falls out. So I guess this is it, again." DON'T DO THAT! STOP seeing yourself failing! So, instead begin to look OVER those past experiences and instead look for the promises that God has ALREADY given and placed in His Word for you. It's the devil that plays back all of the failures NOT God! Remember, He said that He will remember your sins NO MORE?!

God has given us an imagination to dream and see things differently than the way the world sees things. The problem that most of us have had is that we've been derailed by the thoughts or inadequacies that someone else has had in and of their own lives. 'They', sometimes being derailed by someone else in their lives, now pass on to us what they have been led to believe 'they' couldn't do or achieve. 'We' a lot of times as kids or even adults go to someone and share with them our dreams or ambitions and quickly they tell us, "Stop day dreaming. You'll never be able to do that. Come back down to reality." So after awhile 'their' reality bleeds into ours and guess what? We sabotage the dreams that we had by instead of listening to God, we listen to 'their' lack of completions in their own lives. I always encourage our grown children and our growing grandchildren that they can accomplish what they can dream for. Let me share with you all a little something that took place here at grandma and grandpa's house this morning. (Remember, it's still before Christmas here as I'm writing this.)

Several years ago, John and Courtney decided to get this little elf guy from 'Elf on the Shelf' to come play a part in the kids imaginations and Christmas experience. Now I'll get back to where 'I guess I was slightly zealous'. I know today that I was that way then and now because of the love that I was/am experiencing. Like water, I could have taken the route of least resistance. But I'd already been that route and experienced those results for far too long. The new spirit inside of me didn't want to just float along like a dead fish going down stream. I knew very little about this new direction in my life but I believed in the One I was following.

Again, I am no different from any one reading this. As always I'm being transparent when I tell you that it was a slight fear of returning to the old man that compelled and propelled me to want to 'know' more about His love for me. From there I can and will honestly say the old man still tries to buck against me when I'm stepping out to do something new that God has placed in front of me. Instead of listening to that I reflect on all that God has already done in and with this new me, and I take that next step. And guess what? When those thoughts rise up today I quickly realize 'this' must be something big that God is leading me to do or there wouldn't be this much opposition, so I press in. At each new step I take the uneasiness leaves and the confidence in Him draws me forward.

Being so zealous, at first, I began to realize that I was sometimes running ahead of God. I wasn't spiritually ready for some of the things I was headed out on, and yes I messed some things and relationships up, but nothing that He has not been able to restore. Even today I still get excited when I hear 'another part' of what He wants for this ministry as I start to take off towards that certain thing. But with that excitement I'm also learning to not take such big steps until I'm sure I'm walking with Him instead of ahead of Him. Maybe that's why He prefers to show us only a glimpse of the plan and not the

whole picture. You think? I hope that you noticed that I said 'another part' of what He wants for this ministry.

If we get ahead of God and put things 'we' want to do on our plate that plate can fill up pretty fast. Then before we know it we will get discouraged trying to keep up. But when 'He' places something on our plate there is always enough time and energy to accomplish those things. If I get to where I start feeling overwhelmed with 'stuff' I'm learning to stop for a second and examine whether I'm the one putting extra things on that plate. Remember, the devil is perfectly at ease with us being busy and doing 'good things'. Why? Because he knows that while we are doing those 'good things' we usually won't hear when the 'God things' come our way. My suggestion is this ... listen closely. Make sure it's His voice you're hearing and THEN move. I'm sure there's not one of us that doesn't want to accomplish great things for God, and we can when we follow and not lead.

In spite of what some of the church thinks God does not control everything we do. He didn't design and create us to be robots. We don't give our life to Him and then He sends us on our way to figure it all out. His purpose and will for each of us is to be in relationship with Him. In order to have a relationship with my wife or anyone for that matter there has to be some conversations and getting to know each other. Early on in my life, come to find out, I truly didn't know how to have real 'love' relationships. Sure I really cared for people and even said "I love you" and I believe I meant it. But since I've come to allow God to teach me how to love I'm reminded how little I knew about the word 'love'. I believe we throw the word 'love' around way too often. At least I did. Things like I 'love' that motorcycle, I 'love' this watch, I 'love' my dogs, I sure 'love' these burritos, potato chips and on and on. The word 'love' became just a word that seemed like it fit everywhere with no true meaning of 'LOVE". Michelle and I have been together for 26 years and married for close to 25 years now and yes I've been telling her that I 'love' her and I've truly meant it all of this time. And believe me, we're continually working on our relationship and growing closer today than ever. But honestly, it's been since we each have started our own personal relationships with God that we're learning even more of how to 'love' each other. It's only through God teaching each of us how He 'loves' us that's causing us to experience an even deeper level of 'love' together than either of us had known to be possible.

I remember a few times early on in my walk I believed that I had to be down on my knees crying and belly aching and begging God to do things. (Thank God He loves us even in our ignorance.) One of those times in particular we were a little over 1 year into what I knew God had directed us to do, this newsletter. At that time there were a few people that were contributing and helping but even at that point the financial needs were growing almost beyond our means. As I began seeking His direction, in the midst of all that I just mentioned above, it was as though I could see God shrugging His shoulders with both hands in the air saying to me, "What do you want Me to do? I've already given the provision. Go speak to the church." All of a sudden I felt like a spoiled little kid thinking that all of the 'crying and belly aching' was going to make Him do something for me. So I wiped my face and dried the tears and went to where He had told me.

From that time forward I've stopped with all of the nonsense and seek to find His promise for that situation because I've learnt that His promised Word is what moves Him. I've come to realize that He is the One that has set me out on this specific vision and purpose and He will always steer me in the right direction, with the provision to achieve it. I don't have to spend a lot of time trying to figure out how it's all going to work. God gave the vision and He has anointed us to do this particular 'part' He has set before us. I'm completely confident, our plate is not full and that there WILL BE many more 'parts' to come as long as we stay the course He has mapped out.

For now, let me close with this. Not all of us are called to be some big TV evangelist, a pastor of some large church, a missionary overseas or even write a newsletter like we do. Some of us are called to be great spiritual parents to the children that God has entrusted to us. Others are called to be great entrepreneurs that are Kingdom minded. Which means that they bring forth the seed into the 'storehouse' to support the vision/mission that God has called the church too. And that is to preach the Gospel, the Good News that Jesus loves you, to the whole world.

When we get our eyes off of what the world tries to tell us that we can and can't do and get His vision connected with our faith in what He says THEN we'll be able to see ourselves the way that God sees us. And THEN we can begin accomplishing the things that God has set before us to accomplish. Maybe you have had dreams or visions of what you believed you were to accomplish and someone along the way has discouraged that. Let me encourage you today, "Don't lay that aside! It's NEVER too late to pick those hopes, dreams and visions back up and see them through to completion. Seek God's direction in ALL things, follow His lead and you too can accomplish ALL that God has for you!! AMEM?"



Dear friends ... I received a wonderful card from you all yesterday welcoming me into the family. I have to tell you, I've been a bit down and it really lifted my spirits. Awhile ago we had a major riot here and there was major destruction to every part of this prison. We are still locked down and have to be escorted everywhere we go. This prison has been my home for the last 16 years. But I've been in prison for over 28 years now. I must confess that it was so hard to see my 'home' being destroyed and our lives being turned upside down.

We basically have no programs right now and they just started church services this past week. Even with all of this I've been able to go to work the past two weeks. I spend my days on the computer writing new programs for when we do get started again. I just finished a Spanish self-study for the yard. It's a beginners course and today I started the intermediate course. I will be doing an Italian class and I'm working on an American History series too. I've gotten a lot of interest. I find work such joy. I pray to the Lord every night and He gives me the strength and courage to endure. Without Him I don't know where I would be or if I would even be alive.

After I gave my life to the Lord I quit drinking and doing drugs, back on May 5th, 1995. The Lord took those evils from me and I have NEVER craved them once. He also gave me my mind back. I used to be so mixed up and confused but He took that away. Since then I've been able to complete 80 programs here, as well as 20 college courses AND I've maintained a 4.0 GPA, all here in prison. I am so thankful to have Jesus in my life.

I am not a young man, 57 years old, and I have seen so much over the years in here. I try so hard to counsel the younger guys, to steer them away from drugs, alcohol, gambling and gangs. I try to use the teachings of Jesus to do so. I don't always succeed but I've planted a seed.

I'm waiting to go in front of the parole board soon and I am hopeful to be released by the summer. I look forward to meeting all of you at the church services. I also wanted to thank you again for the wonderful newsletters I receive from you all.

Let's get started ...

Stay plugged in to Him! Look, God knows your hearts desires so delight yourselves IN Him and allow Him to bless you.
