So, we're having Science Day in the Classroom on Tuesday, November 20, for grades preK to 6.

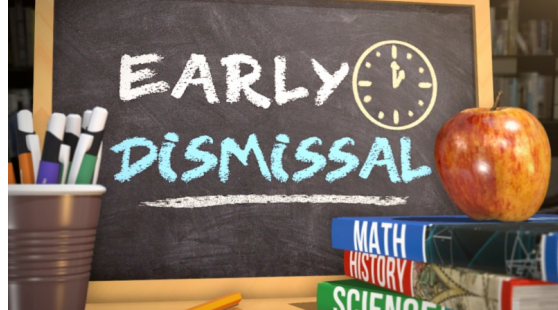


Early Dismissal
