

Wednesday, June 12th 10:30 Bring your bike/scooter/stroller for this special story time at Dimmick by the


playground. We'll enjoy story time, make a license plate for your vehicle,

Teen/Tween Gnome Day


Thursday, June 13th 10:30 Create a gnome decoration, a delicious gnome brownie treat, a felt and paper cup gnome/fairy home and painted

Thursday, June 27th 10:30 We'll have several stations to create different ocean animals! Best for ages 3-12 with an adult.




Lego Ocean Challenge
