Welcome to AWANA Cubbies!!!

First of all we would like to thank you for choosing to send your child to the Cubbie program this year! We are looking forward to another fun, Christ-centered year! We, the leaders enjoy watching the young Cubbies learn about God's love for them and how they can show Jesus' love to others.

Cubbies may arrive at the church around 6:50pm. Cubbies are to come to the fellowship hall upstairs. They are to come in their Cubbie shirt, and bring their book, and bag. Please plan to pick up your child in the fellowship hall where we'll be completing our crafts. If there is bad weather and AWANA is called off, you will be notified by phone.

We'll start with the Welcome to Apple Acres Brochure then we will proceed into the AppleSeed Book. The first year Cubbies will receive their shirt and book on the first club night.

The AppleSeed Book contains 26 Bear Hug Lessons (BH) and 4 Special Day Lessons (SD). Inside your child's book and on the back of this brochure you will find a schedule to help you keep track of which Bear Hug Lesson we are working on. Each week there is a fun story, activity, and memory verse in their book. Please take time during the week to work with your child to help them to learn the memory verse, even 10 minutes per day will help instill the verse into their memory. Please sign each Bear Hug Lesson when you and your child have completed it. This will help the leaders to keep track of what the child has worked on at home. If you feel that your child wants to do more, you'll notice an extra activity called *Under the Apple Tree* located after each Bear Hug Lesson.

At the end of the year, the Cubbies will receive awards upon completion of their books. Your child's bag will need to be returned after your child has completed the Cubbies program. The shirt is their's to keep. The club dues are \$15.00 for the year which can be paid in full the first club meeting or twice a year at \$7.50. Please do

not feel a financial burden because of this. We want your child and/or children to attend AWANA. If it is a concern, please let Carissa or Trish know.
