

What is Work Order Day?

• Work-Ordered Day describes the structure of the day-to-day activity within the Wellness Center Central, in organizing and assisting members develop self-esteem, confidence, and friendships, which make up the foundation of the recovery process. The work Order Day mirrors workplace environment in preparing and supporting members for employment.

Work Order Day

• The work order day is on a volunteer basis with no pay. This means members are contributing their time and efforts freely to help others or support a cause without expecting financial compensation.

Work Order Day

• The Work Order Day is organized into 3 work teams, each of which has sufficient staff, members and meaningful work to sustain a full and engaging work-ordered day. Team meetings and orientations are held to foster relationships as well as to organize, and plan the work of the day.





Administration Team

• This work order covers the administration team schedule of Wellness Center Central in the City of Orange. This may include but not limited to:

Answering incoming calls, assist with making copies, arranging resource table and kiosk, kitchen supplies inventory, art workshop supplies inventory, shopping for cooking class and gardening materials, etc.

Maintenance Team

• This work order covers the scheduled maintenance of Wellness Center Central in the City of Orange. This may include: cleaning the kitchen, sweeping, wiping counters, dusting, picking up litter, taking out trash and watering to maintain WCC's garden.
