

Ferdinand Moeller

1903 — 1953

Ferdinand Moeller, former manager and vice president of Active Industries, Elkton, passed away at his home in Detroit Saturday evening after a long illness. He resigned from his position with the Elkton firm in August, 1951, due to illness.

Mr. Moeller was born in Hamburg, Germany, on February 25, 1903. He came to America in 1927, and lived in Detroit until April 16, 1946, when he came to Elkton. He was active in civic affairs, and was a member of the Wolverine Lodge, Detroit.

Survivors include his widow, Maria; two sons, Fred and Jan, and a step-son, Leonard Burgwell, all of Detroit; a brother, Gunther Moeller, of Pigeon, and his mother, Mrs. Elizabeth Moeller, of Hamburg, Germany.

Funeral services were held Tuesday from the Holy Cross Lutheran Church, Detroit, with burial in the Gethsemane Cemetery, Detroit.
