Regular Meeting -----February 13, 1997

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Gary N. Wilson at 7:00 A.M. at ATTENDANCE the District office. Other Board members present were Bobbie Domenick, Ned Dalton, Karl Tangren, Bill McDougald, James Walker and John Groo.

Special Service District members present were George White, Dan Holyoak, Kevin Johnson, Gary Wilson and Bill McDougald.

Others present were, Dale Pierson, Jolyne Hoffmann, Marsha Modine, George Carter and Don Holvoak.

After calling for additions or corrections to the minutes of the meeting of January 23, MINUTES 1997, and hearing none, the Chair declared the minutes approved as circulated to the APPROVAL Board, Motion: Bill Seconded: Kevin MOTION CARRIED

DON HOLYOAK BILL: Gary said the Don Holyoak bill was still waiting for a response from DON HOLYOAK the attorney. Further discussion will be deferred until the next meeting.

POLICY ON INTER SYSTEM WATER TRANSFERS: The Board reviewed the preliminary 'Policy POLICY ON on Inter System Water Transfers'. The purpose of the policy is to promote conservation of INTER SYS water by minimizing the number of transfers negotiated at the end of the season to cover WATER overuse of irrigation water. The policy is also a cost savings in staff time required to TRANSFERS process the paperwork. Dale stated that the only transfers allowed after the out off dates would be to facilitate irrigation of ground not previously cultivated. James said this policy was decided on last year and was one of the factors causing the (Don and Ray) Holyoak problem. Dale explained that the minutes contained the discussion of the policy but no record of a motion was found to make it official. Dale mentioned that in the last Board meeting Ned suggested waiting until the next irrigation bill goes out to notify our customers. Karl Tangren motioned that transfers be due by the 1st of January and paid by the 1st of February. James seconded. MOTIONED CARRIED

James proposed accepting the policy as written with the date changes agreed upon from Karl's motion. Bobbie seconded. MOTION CARRIED

WATER TO AREA NEAR OLD AIRPORT - DALE PARRIOTT: The water line that runs near the WATER TO old airport was determined to belong to Karl Tangren. Karl said he would not allow the AREA NEAR Speedway to use this line. They will need to put in their own line. Dale will follow up with OLD AIRPORT -Mr. Parriot.

LEASING MOAB IRRIGATION SHARES - CONTRACT: Dale read the contract to the Board. LEASING MIC Verd Duncan's shares were purchased by the District. All others were leased. Ned stated SHARES that the District should have the first right to buy irrigation shares during the lease period CONTRACT and that only the District should be allowed to purchase the shares while the lease is in effect. Dale will revise the contract and present it for the Board review.

ITEMS FROM BOARD MEMBERS: James asked if the District had the measurement device in ITEMS FROM the tunnel yet. Gary said no. Dale explained that the rise in the lake is used currently for BOARD MEMBERS measurement. James said the problem needs to be solved now. If the measurements are not accurate, the budget can be seriously affected for the Moab Irrigation Company, Gary said the solar panels were now here but there was still no answers on how to protect them from theft. George Carter suggested the District could put a Hydro electric generator in the tunnel. The solar panels will be put in as soon as possible.

ITEMS FROM STAFF: Date stated that the specification for a new truck were sent out with ITEMS FROM the meeting minutes for the Board's review. Money was budgeted for the truck over the STAFF last two years. The truck specifications are geared for a Chevy S-10 or Ford Ranger. The staff will advertise for bids prior to first Board meeting in March.

GROUND WATER PROTECTION CONFERENCE: Registration forms for the Ground Water GROUND WATER Protection conference scheduled for May 8th and 9th in Moab were provided to the Board PROTECTION members. Water shed protection issues will be discussed at the conference. Any Board CONFERENCE members interested in attending need to notify staff in the next two weeks so checks can be issued for their registration fees.

DON HOLYOAK COMPLAINT: Mr. Holyoak said he found the District's meeting minutes DON HOLYOAK lacking in a lot of ways and has found numerous errors. He stated that in the previous COMPLAINT meeting he had said that \$2,160.00 would be added to his bill after the Board denied an extension of time to pay his 1997 irrigation water pending the settlement of his complaint.

Dale mentioned to the Board that the staff was looking at purchasing a tape recorder to try to avoid misinterpretations as in the case of Don Holyoak.
