**Ezra 8:35a - The exiles who had come **back** from captivity sacrificed burnt offerings to the God of Israel**

**Nehemiah 13:9 - Then I told them to cleanse the rooms, and I put **back** in there the utensils from God’s temple, the offerings, and the incense.**

**Esther 2:11 - Every day Mordecai would walk **back** and forth in front of the courtyard of the women’s quarters to find out how Esther was and what was happening to her.**

**Job 12:15 - When he holds **back** the waters, there is a drought. When he releases them, they flood the earth.**

**Psalms 145:14 - The Lord supports everyone who falls. He straightens the **backs** of those who are bent over.**

**Proverbs 11:24 - One person spends freely and yet grows richer, while another holds **back** what he owes and yet grows poorer.**

**Ecclesiastes 1:7 - All streams flow into the sea, but the sea is never full. The water goes **back** to the place where the streams began in order to start flowing again.**
