1919 – 1998

Louise Ignash, age 79 of Pigeon, passed away Tuesday, November 17 at Four Seasons Healthcare Center in Bad Axe.

She was born in Meade Township on October 21, 1919, the daughter of the late Nelson and Ethel Mae (Ritter) Ducharme. On November 23, 1940 she was united in marriage to George Anthony Ignash at St. Felix Catholic Church, Hewelton. He preceded her in death on October 6, 1987.
