Due to the Pandemic, we were unable to hold our yearly fundraisers, but the Wetland stayed open and was enjoyed by many as a safe location for much needed outdoor activities.



Thanks to some very wet members of the **Trail Life** group, the dock was moved to a better location. Sandstone steps and bricks were also added for easier access to the dock as part of an ongoing **Eagle Scout Project**.



Heavy rains during the summer months caused flooding and the dock was temporarily under water! Due to an **icy driveway** and parking lot this Winter, 5th Street was closed for a couple of weeks for the safety of our visitors.
