

1. Identify the Main Topic

Choose the central concept you want to map.

Example: **Water Quality**

2. Determine Key Categories (Main Branches)

Identify the major factors or themes related to the main topic. This would be the main topics of the videos.

Example:

Physical Factors

Chemical Factors

Biological Factors

Human Impact

3. Add Subcategories (Sub-branches)

Under each main category, list the relevant sub-factors.

Example:

Physical Factors: Temperature, Turbidity

Chemical Factors: pH, Dissolved Oxygen, Nutrients

Biological Factors: Bacteria, Algae

Human Impact: Pollution, Runoff

4. Draw Connections

Use lines or arrows to connect related concepts.

Example: "Pollution" may link to "Chemical Factors" due to contaminants in water.

5. Keep It Simple & Readable

Use clear labels and avoid excessive details.

Color-code or group similar ideas to improve clarity.
