

APPOINTMENT TO THE HIGH SCHOOL BOARD

POLICY

The Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-Four is one of three component school districts, together with Valley Stream School Districts Thirteen and Thirty, which constitute the Valley Stream Central High School District.

Each of the Valley Stream component districts send three of its Board members to serve on the Valley Stream Central High School Board. Together, the nine board members constitute the Valley Stream Central High School Board of Trustees.

At its Annual Reorganization Meeting (see below) the Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-Four will select three of its members to serve on the Valley Stream Central High School Board. This is an annual appointment that may, or may not, be renewed.

Any incumbent member of Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-Four Board will advise the entire Board of his/her interest in serving on the High School board prior to the May public meeting of District Twenty-Four preceding the Annual Meeting. The entire Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-Four Board will consider a candidate's interest in serving on the High School board at its June work session. Among other factors that should be considered in the selection of a High School board member include, but are not limited to, length of tenure on District Twenty-Four's Board, prior experience on the High School board, the need to rotate Board members to assure full participation in all District Twenty-four educational issues, the candidate's personal background, and other factors that would promote the objectives and mission of the Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-Four.

In the event that there are more than three Board members demonstrating an interest in serving on the High School board, selection will be made by a majority vote of the entire Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-four Board at its annual Reorganization Meeting.

In the event of a vacancy, for any reason, the President of the Valley Stream Union Free School District Twenty-four Board of Education, in consultation with the entire Board, will appoint a member of the District Twenty-Four to fulfill the balance of the term.
