## Mission

The SCWD Youth Group's mission is to provide teaching and support for youth aged eight to eighteen and parents or a sponsor for the advancement of their skills in the hobby of model railroading. Along with these skills we work to instill a spirit of cooperation, respect for others, teamwork and patience.

## Hands-on Clinics

Youth and parents or a sponsor have the opportunity to participate in hands-on clinics to learn about all aspects of model railroading, including planning and track work, bench work and scenery, model building and electronics, painting, engine maintenance and repair, and operating a model railroad.

## Expert Advice and Support

The SCWD Youth Group is financially supported by the SCWD. Experienced members locate meeting spaces, provide needed clinic materials and find qualified model railroaders to teach at the clinics.



## Meetings

The SCWD Youth Group meets once a month from September through May. Members are also welcome to attend the monthly SCWD meetings for adults. The adult meetings run from the second Sunday in September through the first Sunday in May and feature educational clinics, refreshments, photo and model contests, door prizes, and access to local Madison layouts.
