



To: District Commissioners & State Tournament Directors

Subject: GAME CONDUCT

1. All games will be played under rules and regulations covered in the Professional Baseball Rule Book, Rules and Regulations of Babe Ruth Baseball and any local tournament rules.
2. Games will be kept moving at all times. No unnecessary delay or mound conferences, etc. will be permitted.
3. Anyone, including players, coaches and managers acting in a non-sportsman like manner shall be removed from the playing field or ballpark immediately and could cause disqualification from the tournament.
4. Managers, coaches and players shall wear full uniforms according to Baseball Rules. While in uniforms, neatness is a must.
5. Protective headgear must be worn at bat and on the bases.
6. Equipment- bats, gloves, helmets, etc., shall be stacked neatly in the dugout in their proper places at all times.
7. Only players, coaches, the manager and batboy shall be allowed in the dugouts. Players must stay inside the dugouts.
8. Masks with throat protector will be required at all times when warming up the pitcher, whether on the field or in the bullpen.
9. No Tobacco will be permitted on the playing field, dugout or restroom by a manager, coaches or player of a team while engaged in a regular scheduled game.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The District Commissioner shall have the authority to remove any player, coach or manager for actions detrimental to Babe Ruth Baseball. Any misbehavior or misconduct on or off the field could cause the disqualification of a manager, coach, player or of the entire team from the tournament.
2. The tournament is under the jurisdiction of the District Commissioner and Tournament Director.
3. The Protest Committee shall have the final authority in all protests.
4. The Protest Committee shall be appointed by the Tournament Director in accordance with the southwest Regional Commissioner or his assistant.
