### **Centennial Barn**

The Director of the Barn is no longer employed at FM as of 4/13. This occurs as business is picking up and there many bookings ahead. Staff have stepped in to help. With the possibility of outsourcing the Barn, interim plans to cover and manage booked events are pending.

### **Community Garden**

The spring Garden activity is in full swing. The Garden remains popular and has a waiting list.

### **Haircuts from the Heart**

The salon continues to operate at Mary Magdalen House with only one stylist. We are making efforts to revive the mobile service. Our furloughed part-time stylist, has resigned after more than a year of no work.

### **Tamar's Center**

Tamar's center reopened to a limited number of inside clients as of April 5.

### **Tau House**

Bookings continue to be low at Tau House. There are only four for the 2021 summer season due to continued school restrictions on such activities.

### **Executive Director Activity**

In the area of development, we have received several nice donations: \$5000 from an individual, \$10,000 from the local SFP Sisters as a Raise the Roof starter for Tamar's, and funds from the Peddler of more than \$8000 (just received).

Following the retreat there has been considerable activity related to Barn outsourcing, planning for Executive Director transition, PPP forgiveness and new PPP application, liquor license renewal, audit, and the annual appeal follow-up.
