1905-1993

Elmer C. Uhl, 88, a native of Sebawaing and most recently a resident of Shelby Township, died Monday, Dec. 27, at his home.

He was born in Sebawaing on Nov. 29, 1905, a son of John and Louise (Flegel) Uhl. He was confirmed April 13, 1919, in Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sebawaing. He was united in marriage with Helen Engal on Nov. 21, 1940, in Trinity Lutheran Church, Forestville.

Mr. Uhl was an optician by profession, and retired Feb. 27, 1971. The Uhls then moved to the Cassville Area for a number of years, returning to southeastern Michigan several years ago to be nearer their family. He was a member of St. Peter Lutheran Church, Macomb, the Lutheran Laymen's League and Sixty-Plus Club.

Surviving are his wife, Helen, two daughters, Marilyn (Keith) Todd of Shelby Township and Donna (Robert) Heidrich of Romeo, four grandchildren, Michael, Rebecca, Rachel and Andrew, and one sister, Mabel Bell of Roseville.

The funeral service was conducted at St. Peter Church at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 29, with Rev. Robert E. Kasper officiating. Burial was in Glen Eden Cemetery, Livonia.
