

The first story of the cross gable has a cut-away bay accentuated by scroll brackets. There is a two-tiered, recessed porch flanking the cross gable. It is supported on the first story by turned columns trimmed with scroll brackets; sawn balustrades enclose the upper porch. Wall cladding details have been obscured by asbestos shingle siding. | 17. History and Significance This house was built in 1903 by Albert Schlesselman to demonstrate his talents as a carpenter, and incorporated many of the high style elements of the period. A feature of note is that the house was originally built * as a two family structure, and, as far as is known, was the only two family house constructed on the isl.
