

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-07

**A RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR NOVEMBER 3, 2020;  
APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH GRAND COUNTY  
CONCERNING THE COORDINATED ELECTION; AND REFERRING A BALLOT  
ISSUE TO THE REGISTERED ELECTORS AT SUCH ELECTION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. Section 31-10-108, the Board of Trustees may call a special election by resolution adopted not less than 60 days prior to the date of the election; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds it is in the best interest of the Town to call a special election to be held on November 3, 2020 as part of the State general election to refer one or more ballot issues to the registered electors of the Town pursuant to Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds it is in the best interest of the Town to coordinate the special election with Grand County and desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the County to define and clarify each party's obligations with respect to the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF KREMMLING, COLORADO:

**Section 1.** Pursuant to C.R.S. Section 31-10-108, a special election for the Town of Kremmling is hereby called and set for Tuesday, November 3, 2020 to be held as part of a coordinated election with Grand County.

**Section 2.** The purpose of the special election will be to refer to the voters one or more ballot issues or questions as determined by the Board of Trustees.

**Section 3.** The officers and employees of the Town are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and appropriate actions to effectuate the provision of this Resolution in accordance with Colorado law.

**Section 4.** Pursuant to C.R.S. Section 31-10-102.7, the Town will utilize the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992, articles 1 to 13 of title 1, C.R.S., as amended, in lieu of the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965, article 10 of title 31, C.R.S., as amended, with respect to the special municipal election to be held on November 3, 2020, and such election shall be conducted as part of the coordinated election. The Town Clerk is hereby appointed as the designated election official of the Town for purposes of performing acts required or permitted by law in connection with the election.

**Section 5.** The following ballot issue, certified in substantially the form set forth below, is hereby referred to the registered electors of the Town of Kremmling and shall appear on the ballot of the special election to be held on November 3, 2020:

WITHOUT INCREASING TOTAL TAX REVENUES COLLECTED, SHALL THE TOWN OF KREMMLING BE AUTHORIZED TO ADJUST ITS MILL LEVY ANNUALLY TO OFFSET REVENUE REDUCTIONS CAUSED BY STATE IMPOSED CHANGES TO THE PERCENTAGE USED TO DETERMINE ASSESSED VALUATION, INCLUDING ANY CHANGES MADE PURSUANT TO THE 1982 GALLAGHER AMENDMENT TO THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, SO THAT, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE:

1. THE REVENUES GENERATED BY SUCH MILL LEVY ARE THE SAME AS THE TAX REVENUES THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN GENERATED HAD SUCH CHANGES IN THE METHOD OF CALCULATING ASSESSED VALUATION NOT OCCURRED, AND;

2. THE TOWN OF KREMMLING CAN SUSTAIN ITS ABILITY TO PROVIDE MUNICIPAL SERVICES SUCH AS PUBLIC SAFETY, SNOW REMOVAL, INFRASTRUCTURE REPAIRS, AND GENERAL SERVICES.

**Section 6.** The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement with Grand County concerning the coordinated election is hereby approved in essentially the same form as the copy of such Intergovernmental Agreement accompanying this resolution. The Mayor or Town Manager and Town Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement and are hereby further authorized to negotiate and approve such revisions to the Intergovernmental Agreement as are determined necessary or desirable for the protection of the Town, so long as the essential terms and conditions of the Intergovernmental Agreement are not altered.


