Special Council Meeting
Friday, January 23, 2026

CALL TO ORDER: Chairwoman Randi Lone Eagle called the Special Meeting of Friday, January 23, 2026 to order at 9:00 am.

ROLL CALL: Secretary/Treasurer, Philip Frank called the roll: Chairwoman Randi Lone Eagle, present; Vice-Chairwoman, Nedra Crane, present; Secretary/Treasurer, Philip Frank, present; Council Member Scott Cory Burdette, excused; and Council Member, Cherice Trejo, present.

STAFF: Austin New Moon, Housing Manager and Pantry Coordinator

GUEST: Sarah and Chelsea, Northern Nevada Food Bank

This meeting was to discuss the differences in Summit Lake Paiute Tribe's policies and the Food Bank of Northern Nevada policies.

Areas of concern:

Tribal Enrollment Information: SLPT Pantry personnel was told that it was okay to ask, now they are being told it is not okay. There was discussion. SLPT has a grant that states that the food purchased is for SLPT tribal members and their families, so it is necessary to check enrollment status. The consensus was that it was okay to ask for tribal affiliations, but that the IDs not be copied for FBNN.

Free FBNN items placed in the front common area: It is okay to have those items in the front common area.

SLPT was told it was okay to open to Native Americans, now they are told it must be open to everyone: Ms. Torres said their policies required that their items be served to everyone.

SLPT Pantry was promised appliances:
SLPT has not received any. This was discussed as yes and no, capacity building.

There was a grant where food and reusable bags were requested. The grant covered no food so only the reusable bags were funded.

Ms. Torres said to send the pantry needs over to FBNN.

Other Items Discussed

- The pantry has no scanner.
- The food requested was Native driven.
- 21,000 pounds of food was supplied by FBNN
- Ms. Torres offered a tour of the FBNN.

MOTION: Vice-Chairwoman Nedra Crane moved to adjourn. Secretary/Treasurer Philip Frank seconded. Chairwoman Randi Lone Eagle called the vote: 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 ABSTAINED. Meeting adjourned at 10:00 am.


