Effective June 25, 2020, New York State, New Jersey and Connecticut have announced a joint incoming travel advisory that all individuals traveling from states with significant community spread of Covid-19 must quarantine for a 14 day period from the time of last contact within the identified states. Significant community spread is defined as any state with a positive test rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents over a 7- day rolling average or a state with 10% or higher positivity rate over a 7-day rolling average. As of June 26, 2020 this quarantine applies to the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Idaho, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Nevada, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah.

The list of prohibited states where such community spread occurred, will be updated regularly by New York State. Please check the following link for the updated list of states:

In response to the NYS directives, employees returning from travel to a designated state may return to work but only after being tested for COVID-19. Testing should be done as soon as possible (within 24hrs) to ensure they are not positive. A returning employee should notify Keith Scherberger, Community Hab Coordinator to schedule a date of return to work.

If the employee test negative for COVID-19, they may return to work but should continue to monitor temperature and symptoms for the next 14 days. If the employee test positive, they must quarantine at home for 14 days.

A returning employee who declines to be tested must quarantine at home for 14 days as per the Governor's directives and will not be eligible for pay during this time period and will not be on a job protected leave.

Please note that the policy related to travel restrictions is subject to change as the situation evolves.

These restrictions are an important representation of our commitment to controlling the impact of COVID-19 on the health and safety of all person's supported and employee's.
