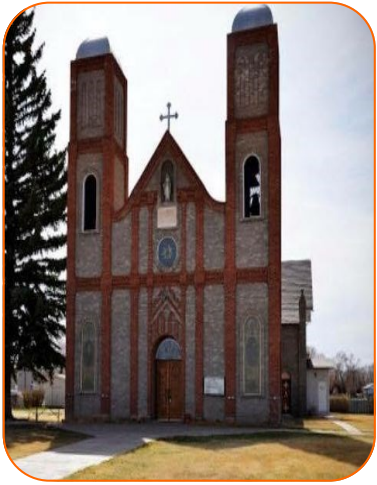


El Santuario de los Pobladores

Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. Gravel has been spread in front and around the east and west sides of the labyrinth. Trees (6) have been planted. As donations are received, more trees will be placed. We have also planted shrubs and flower bushes and surrounded the area with gravel. Adobe dedication plaques are now in place in the labyrinth courtyard and placement of plaques continue. Once all these are in place, merchants who have supported our project, will also be acknowledged. Each outlying mission will have its own mission statue displayed when funds are available. Please support the volunteers seeking contributions from your placita. Your continued patience & cooperation is greatly appreciated as we work with volunteers in this phase of our project. St. Augustine & Holy Family statues are now in place at the Santuario. In addition, statues of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego will be placed at the entrance and donations are being accepted to begin this phase. Placement of new trees will also be available to contributors interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. Theme: Christians Are God's Living Temple

Each congregation celebrates the annual memorial of the dedication of its church. However, the church building can only be an effective sign of God's presence to his people, and as such a type or image of the heavenly city Jerusalem, if the members of the congregation let themselves be built like living stones into a spiritual temple with Christ as the foundation. Today, Christians celebrate the dedication of the basilica of St. John Lateran, the Cathedral of the Holy Father, in Rome. In union with all Christians of the world, we should be like a temple in which are offered sacrifices of good works that are pleasing to God (1 Pt 2:5).

FIRST READING Ez 47:1-2, 8-9, 12
[Life-Giving Temple]

The title for this reading given by the Church in the Lectionary is: "I saw water flowing from the temple, and all who were touched by it were saved." This text is a figure of the life that flows from the new temple (which signifies our churches and the Body of Christ) and from the new worship brought by Christ. It will be like a stream that will overflow the earth, producing trees, herbs, and fruits that will become the food and medicine of human beings. Even in the spiritual realm, water is a sign and promise of life. "Come! behold the deeds of the *Lord*, the astounding things he has wrought on earth" (Responsorial Psalm).

SECOND READING 1 Cor 3:9c-11, 16-17
[God's Building]

The Church is built up by the efforts of man. "But each one must be careful how he builds upon it, for no one can lay a foundation other than the one that is there, namely, Jesus Christ." Furthermore, the community is the dwelling and property of God. Consequently, any attack against its integrity is an attack against God himself.

The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

“To dedicate or consecrate” a place to God is a ritual
that is found in every religion. To “reserve” a place to
God is an act of recognizing His glory and honor.
When the Emperor Constantine granted full liberty to
Christians in 313, they did not spare in order to con-
struct places for the Lord – numerous are the church-
es constructed at that time. Constantine himself also
constructed churches, one of which he was a magnifi-
cent basilica on the Caelian Hill in Rome, over the
ancient Lateran Palace, which Pope Sylvester I dedi-
cated to Christ the Savior (318 or 324). A chapel dedi-
cated to Saint John the Baptist was built inside it
which served as the baptistry. This moved Pope Ser-
gius III to dedicate it to Saint John the Baptist as
well. Lastly, Pope Lucius II also dedicated it to Saint
John the Evangelist in the 12th century. Thus, the
name of this Papal Basilica is the Basilica of the Most
Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John
the Evangelist in the Lateran. Christians consider the
Basilica to be the mother church of all churches in the
world. The church was destroyed several times in the
course of the centuries, and always rebuilt. The final
reconstruction took place under the pontificate of
Benedict XIII. The church was rededicated in 1724. It
was at that time that the feast celebrated today was
established and extended to the universal Church.
