



1. Encourage Visible Signs of Faith

A Nativity scene on the front yard, a "Keep Christ in Christmas" magnet on a car, or a blessed wreath on one's door - these quiet signs speak loudly. We can promote and distribute religious Christmas items, helping families place reminders of Christ's birth at the center of their homes.

2. Support Parish Liturgies and Devotions

Christmas is ultimately celebrated most profoundly at the altar. Assisting at Advent liturgies and inviting lapsed Catholics to return for Christmas Mass are all ways to lead hearts back to the Lord.

3. Serve Those in Need

The Holy Family knew poverty and uncertainty. When we support food drives, visit the elderly, or provide assistance to families in difficulty, we honor the Child of Bethlehem. Charity is one of the most eloquent ways to proclaim Christ.


5. Live the Season with Reverence and Joy

Hello there! My name is Emily Meyer. I am 20 years old, a junior in college and the founder of the Emily Meyer Foundation. I wanted to tell you about a toy drive I started fifteen years ago:

On Christmas night in 2009, I became very sick and was admitted to Good Samaritan Hospital.

The next day, a Child Life Representative greeted me with a large gift bag filled with toys.
