

This afternoon, visit the Aquincum Museum. After dinner, enjoy a city walk that brings you to the Arizona Night Club, as featured in Alma's letters.



Ljubljana, Slovenia June 12 & 13:

Old Square before crossing the Dragon Bridge on the way to Market Square. See the town's most recognizable sights, the Triple Bridge, City Hall Square and the Bishop's Palace . . .



This morning drive to Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia and a multicultural city noted for its many fine museums and medieval architecture. Stop en route at Balaton Lake before arriving in time for dinner. (B,D)



ZAGREB, Croatia June 14, 2025

 Drive to Zagreb this morning. Upon arrival enjoy a sightseeing tour with a local guide, including highlights of both Gornji grad, & Upper Town; and Donji grad; Lower Town. Marvel at coat of arms tiled onto the colorful roof of St. Mark's Church, gaze sky-high at the twin neo-Gothic spires of Zagreb Cathedral, feel the lively buzz of Dolac

 Market and see the statue of Ban Jelacic in his namesake square. (B,D)



SPLIT JUNE 16: UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE


See the relics of Diocletian's Palace, a palace and fort built by the retired Roman emperor in the 4th century around which the city itself has grown. The afternoon is yours to explore more at your own pace. Perhaps visit Bacvice beach to watch locals play the unique game of picigin, invented here, or hike Marjan Hill for beautiful birds-eye views of the old town and harbor. (B,D)



DUBROVNIK JUNE 17 8 18

Today follow in the footsteps of the De Luce couple with a morning tour of the Sponza Palace. This afternoon explore the Island of Lokrum with its coves and caves. After dinner enjoy free time in the city maybe exploring the Kafana for traditional music. (B,D)





Athens: June 19 & 20

 Say farewell to Croatia & enjoy a free afternoon in Athens where you will begin to explore this enchanting, ancient city. June 19 & 20

• Greet the day with a guided sightseeing tour that reveals the glories of ancient Greece. Ascend to the top of the Acropolis and visit the iconic Parthenon. Then view the Agora, followed by a stroll through the Acropolis Museum, a modern architectural jewel. This afternoon stroll through history by visiting the Temple of Jupiter, Stadium Street, and Roosevelt Street near Hotel Grande Bretagne where the De Luce couple stayed briefly. (B,D)



Nauplia, Greece June 21

 Journey to the great Theater of Epidaurus and visualize 14,000 ancient spectators who sat here all day long, held spellbound by tragedies of Sophocles or comedies of Aristophanes.

• Dine on a traditional, countryside Greek BBQ lunch; included instead of dinner, then drive to Mycenae to see mainland Europe's oldest city, including the Lion Gate, Royal Tombs and Acropolis. B/L




Sponge boat captain & Alma heading to Turkey April 1941
