

Ordinance No. 2

Relating to misdemeanors, public morals and deportment

The village council of the village of New Munich do ordain as follows

Section I. All open or notorious drunkenness, brawling, obscene, profane language and deportment, and indecent exposure of the person in any of the streets, alleys or public places in said village of New Munich, and all riots and affrays and riotous conduct, immoral and offensive noises and disturbances, breaches of the peace, fighting or quarreling in any of the said streets, alleys, stores, saloons or other public places or private dwellings and all shooting or discharging of fire arms, and the wanton wilful or malicious throwing of stones, sticks, or other offensive or injurious missiles in any of the said streets or alleys, and all wanton, wilful or malicious disturbance of any religious or other public meeting, school or assemblage within the limits of said Village are hereby prohibited.

Sec. II. Any person or persons who shall violate any of the above provisions of Section one of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine, not less than one nor more than one hundred dollars, together with the cost of suit, or be committed to the county jail of Stearns County or to the village jail of said village of New Munich not to exceed ninety days, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the village justice.

Sec. III. All lotteries, gift enterprises, all descriptions of gaming, fraudulent devices and practices and slight of hand tricks and performances, and all playing of cards, dices or other game of chance for the purpose of gaming, or for gain of

money or other valuable thing, within the limits of said village, are hereby prohibited, and no owner or person having charge or control of any building or room in said village shall lease or let the same or any part thereof, to be used for any of the purposes aforesaid, and no owner or other person having charge or control of any hotel, saloon, or other public place within said village, shall allow or permit any gaming, fraudulent devices or practices, slight of hand tricks or performances, playing of cards, dice, or other game of chance for the purpose of gaming or for gain of money or other valuable thing, upon the premises, owned or occupied by him, or of which he has charge and control.

Sec. IV.

Any person, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of section three of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, or be committed to the county jail of Stearns County, or the village jail of said village not to exceed ninety days or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Village Justice.

Sec. V.

No person, company or corporation shall keep or maintain within the limits of the village of New Munich any house of prostitution or ill fame; or any house, booth, tent or other place for the purpose of prostitution or illicit sexual intercourse, nor in which prostitution or illicit sexual intercourse is allowed or permitted, nor shall any owner or other person, occupying any house, tenement, building, booth, tent, or room of any kind

allow or permit the same to be used or frequented, or resorted to for any of the purposes or acts above prohibited.

Sec. VI.

No person shall within the limits of said village, ply or carry on the business of prostitution, or promiscuous or illicit sexual intercourse, nor upon or within any street, alley, saloon, hotel, store or other public building, or place of public resort within said village either by written or oral language, gesture, lascivious deportment, or other means, solicit, invite or attempt to entice any person to patronize or visit any home or place of prostitution or to patronize or to have any lewd or lascivious intercourse or association with any prostitute.

Sec. VII.

Any person, persons, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of section five and six of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not less than fifty nor more than one hundred dollars together with the cost of prosecution or committed to the county jail of Stearns County or the village jail of said village not to exceed sixty days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the village justice.

Sec. VIII.

No person or person shall speed, race or immoderately drive or ride or cause to be driven or ridden, any team, horse or mule, in or upon any public street, highway or alley, within said Village of New Munich: nor shall any person having the care or being in charge of any team, horse, or mule, leave the same in or upon any street, highway, alley, or enclosed lot, yard or other uninclosed place within the said village, without such team or animal being safely and securely hitched or fastened to some stationary object of sufficient strength to prevent

such team or animal from escaping or going at large; nor shall any person having the care or being in charge of any team, horse, mule or other animal, tie, or hitch any such team, horse, mule or other animal to any fence, building, shade, ornamental or fruit tree not his own, within said village, without the express consent of the owner, of such building, fence or tree.

Sec. VIII

No person, company or corporation shall encumber any street, sidewalk or public alley in said village with, nor leave thereupon any wood, timber, lumber, bales, boxes, barrels, wares or merchandise, machines, wags, sleigh, sleds, ashes, rubbish or other incumbrance, whatever; nor drive any team or vehicle upon any sidewalk in said village except at the proper crossings; provided, that any such article in process of being conveyed to or from any premises adjacent to any street, sidewalk or alley, may be allowed to remain thereupon a reasonable length of time to admit their being loaded or unloaded and conveyed to or from such premises; and, provided further, that whenever any person, company or corporation is engaged or is about to engage in building or making other improvements upon any premises adjacent to any such sidewalk, street or public alley, and the character of such building or improvement or the situation of such premises render it necessary to occupy or encumber a part of such street, sidewalk or alley with material to be removed from such premises, or to be employed in such building or improvement it shall be lawful to occupy and use so much of such street, sidewalk or alley for

such purpose as shall be necessary therefor and for such reasonable length of time as shall be necessary therefor, but in all cases a sufficient space shall be left unincumbered for the safe passage and repassage of teams and pedestrians along such street and sidewalk or alley; and such incumbrance shall be promptly removed by the party causing the same as soon as such necessity ceases to exist.

Sec. X.

No person shall throw or deposit any ashes into or upon any street or public alley in said village, nor deposit or keep any ashes not entirely free from fire, live coals, and cinders in any wooden ash house or other wooden receptacle, nor within such distance, of any wooden building structure, or fence, so as to endanger the same, within the said village.

Sec. XI.

No person, company or corporation shall permit the copulation of animals within the limits of the Village of New Munich, except the same be in an enclosure or excluded from public view.

Sec. XII

No person shall make a riot, countenance, or assist in making any noise, disturbance or improper diversion for any purpose whatsoever, within the limits of the village of New Munich.

Sec. XIII

That no person or child shall throw stones or other missiles, or shoot arrows or sling shots or coast with sleds upon any public street or alley within the limits of the village of New Munich.

Sec. XIII

No person, company, or corporation shall keep or expose for sale within the village of New Munich any diseased or unwholesome fish, fowl, or fowls.

Any person, persons, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions
