

Recital Information and Upcoming "2021" Dates



We are so excited about our upcoming recital! It will be done in a similar fashion as last season but grouped into quarters so the audience can enjoy more routines and the dancers can participate in a finale. Please read below for more details. Below you will find your recital time for **Saturday, June 19** (rain date of June 20 with same times). The event will be held at **Oakland Park, 76 Oakland Street, Medway, MA**. To defray the cost of this event for music, sound, flooring, curtains, live stream, etc. we will be selling tickets for \$15 each (cash or check). Because of COVID restrictions, right now each dancer will be allowed 2 tickets. Tickets will be on sale at the studio during regular business hours May 24 – June 12. If anyone needs an extra ticket, please let us know and we will do our best to accommodate your need. Extra tickets, if available, can be purchased at the studio June 14-16 on a first come first served basis. If the numbers for outdoor gatherings are increased, so will our allowed number of tickets per dancer/family. If dancers are appearing in more than one segment, parents will only need to purchase tickets for one segment. Once tickets are collected at Oakland Park, a wrist band will be put on guests.

This event will also be live streamed, so that other family and friends can watch from home. That information will be emailed separately and closer to the date. We will also be recording and editing a recital DVD which will be available for sale. Please see DVD information below.

Please arrive **15 minutes prior to your start time** as listed below. Dancers should come dressed in costume with hair and light make-up (optional). Dancers who need to change will be able to do so in tents set up in the “back stage” area. Costumes and shoes for changing can be left “back stage” as well. Parents should help with changing and we suggest wearing a camisole leotard or other dance undergarments so that nobody needs to be fully undressed. Masks must be worn by all attending. Dancers will be wearing masks backstage and when they perform.

Our stage will be set up on the basketball courts. We will have a Marley floor for the dancers to dance on, side wings and back curtains. The audience will watch from the grass area. Please feel free to bring a blanket or chair to sit on. The audience will be open seating. Here, you will be able to spread out and social distance with your family. If you bring a pop-up tent, you will be asked to set up off to the side to avoid blocking the view for others. Also, pop-up tents must be weighted down and stakes can **not** be used as the field has an irrigation system. This is a rule by the Town of Medway

Each young dancer should sit with their parents. When it's time to dance, the SBS staff will gather the dancers and bring them back stage to line up to perform. After they dance, another SBS staff member will bring the dancers back to their area. Older dancers can wait back stage. We will have areas for hand sanitizing and the park does have a bathroom.

To adhere to the governor's regulations, we can only host the specified groups and their 2 guests for each quarter. Each family must be socially distanced while watching the show and masks must be worn. We are strongly encouraging people to watch from home via the live stream.

If dancers have a break, they can leave and come back later. If you plan on staying during the break, we ask that you go to a part of the park not used by SBS.

Oakland Park has sufficient parking but any overflow can park at the senior center. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time and allot time to park. Any early arrivals should wait in the car. Once the prior section has left, the next will be let in and the show will proceed.

Other Dates to Remember

May 7 – 13: Costume Time: Costumes have already been tried on in class and will be sent home with the students **May 7 -13.** Some costumes may need straps sewn or tutu's tacked (very limited sewing). We will email all costume information including hair and make-up. **Costumes can only be taken home when account balances are paid in full.**

May 7 - 17: Order **Recital T-shirts** & more from our on-line store. We will email the link and post it on our website.

Monday, May 24 – Saturday, June 12: The Recital tickets will go on sale at the studio during regular studio hours (Mon – Thurs 4 to 9 pm, Fri 4 to 8 pm, Sat 9 am to 2 pm). The cost will be \$15 each (cash or check) and all sales are final. Because of Covid restrictions, each dancer will be allowed 2 tickets to attend the show. The show will be run in quarters. Parents/guests are permitted to watch any quarter that their dancer is performing in.

May 29 - 31: No Classes Saturday – Monday in observation of Memorial Day.

June 7 - 12: Last week of classes.

Monday, June 14 - Wednesday, June 16: Picture and Dance In Costume Day: Pictures will be taken by Gary Antle Photography, at the studio. Both group and individual pictures will be taken during the assigned times and then the dancers will practice their dance in costume so that we don't have any costume issues.
