It is from all of you that many reports were submitted giving us information we can take to our Legislators to change and improve our Election laws. If you were at Poll Observer for the Primary watch for email updates from Chairman Niland or Heidi Grande.

Political parties, including legislative districts, are required to provide the name, address, occupation, and employer, along with a phone number or email address for all transactions. If you make a donation or purchase a name badge using the online form or QR code, please make sure that you email me your completed donation or purchase forms at <u>djtrudeau@gmail.com</u>. I was asked about accepting Zelle donations directly to our bank account. The LD's bank account is a "business account." The bank informed me that business accounts are unable to accept transfer payments, such as a "Zelle" payment. We are able to accept cash, checks and credit card donations and purchases.
